  - The proposed project is proposed for Construction of 4/5 Star Hotel and Convention Center at Village - Kotra Sultanabad, Dist. Bhopal, MP. The project involves the Construction of 4/5 Star hotel and Convention Center with 220 Rooms, Convention / banquet facilities of 2700 sqm. (Indoor and Outdoor space), meeting rooms, executive lounge and business center, restaurants (4 nos.), health club & Spa.
  - As per the T & CP, Bhopal (vide letter no.BPLLP-2703 dtd 20.11.17) total land area is 1.619 ha (16194.0 sq.m.) Khasra No. 40/3 & 276/3 at Village - Kotra Sultanabad, Dist. Bhopal, MP.
  - The total built-up area proposed by PP is 45828.0 sq. m sq.m. The project comes under 8 (a) category (B) of schedule of EIA Notification, 2006 because total construction is less than 1, 50,000 sq m. and land is less than 50 ha.
  - 4. It is noted that the project site is approx. 1.2 km away from the van vihar for which PP has applied for online for NBWL Clearance (a notified PA) and recently MoEF&CC has notified Van Vihar ESZ vide Notification S.O. 3777(E) dated 29.11.2017 which is 100 meters from the boundary of the van vihar national park.
  - No water bodies passing through the project area however Bhadbhada Dam: 0.92 KM. (S) Kaliyasot Dam: 3.0 KM. (S) away from the project site. PP has Submitted NOC (dtd.10.11.17) from Lake Conservation cell of Bhopal Municipal Corporation regarding construction of the hotel.

  - The case was discussed in 468<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 09.02.2017 and invited for presentation in further upcoming meeting of SEIAA.
  - 8. After deliberations by PP the case was discussed in depth & it is noted that:

(i). Regarding land documents PP has submitted Khasra Panchsala 2015-16. As per Khasra Panchsala the land is in the name of it's a land of MP State

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Tourism Development Corporation and lease has been allotted to Genex Hotels Pvt. Ltd. The lease was executed between between Maneging Director Madhya Pradesh Tourism Development Corporation Ltd.and M/s M/s Genex Hotel Pvt. Ltd.. through Director Shri Amit Sinha S/o Raghuwansh Bhushan Sinha (dtd. 14.03.16).

- (ii). The total water requirement is 335 KLD. The fresh water requirement is 263 KLD & recycled water is 225 KLD. The source of water supply is Municipal Corporation, Bhopal. PP has submitted letter (dtd. 04.01.2018) from Municipal Corporation Bhopal for supply of 297 KLD water.
- (iii). The total waste water generation is 277 KLD. PP has provided sewage treatment plant of 300 KLD (250KLD STP+ 50KLD ETP). The total treated waste water is 225 KLD. PP has proposed 225 KLD recycle & re-used 100%.if necessary it is proposed to be disposed off in municipal sewer line. PP has submitted letter (dtd. 03.01.2018) from Nagar Nigam Bhopal for disposal of extra treated waste water.
- (iv). The Municipal Solid waste 1.77549 (TPD) per day shall be generated. The generated biodegradable and non biodegradable waste will be segregated at source within the campus. The wet garbage will be treated in Organic Waste Convertor (OWC) & will be used as manure for landscaping. The recyclable dry garbage disposed off to the vendors for recycling. All non recyclable waste including sludge from STP will be disposed off at trenching ground of Municipal Corporation. PP has submitted letter dtd. 03.01.2018 issued from Bhopal Municipal Corporation for disposal of solid waste.
- (v). The generated hazardous waste spent Oil from transformer & DG set (approx. 300 l/yr.) will be disposed off as per hazardous waste (Management and Handling Rules). This spent oil will be carefully stored in HDPE drums in isolated covered facility. This spent oil will be sold to vendors authorized by MPPCB for the treatment of same.
- (vi). PP has proposed the maximum height of the building is 43.5m. PP has provided Front MOS 15.0 m and side / rear MOS 7.50 m. As per MP Bhumi Vikas Niyam 2012 rule 42 (2) road width 30 m and above front MOS 15.0 m & side / rear 7.50 m for building up to 45 m height.
- (i). PP has proposed to provide fire water storage tank, Fire pumping system, External Fire Hydrant System, Wet Riser System, Fire extinguisher, automatic Sprinkler System, & Fire Alarm system. etc. as per NBC 2005. PP has also submitted provisional fire fighting NOC issued by Municipal Corporation Bhopal dtd. 12.01.18.
- (vii). PP has proposed roof top rain water harvesting system plan for ground water recharging and proposed 02 nos. of recharging pits and 1 Nos. Rainwater Storage Tank for storing 100 KLD of water.
- (viii). The total power requirement is 1936.1 KW. The source of electricity is Madhya Pradesh Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company Limited. PP has also provided power back up 3 x 1000 KVA each and 2 Nos. 40 KVA UPS. For control of energy PP has proposed Installing programmable on/off timers

and sensors for low occupancy areas Use of compact fluorescent lamps and low voltage lighting. Sunscreen films on windows to reduce heating inside the buildings. Low voltage light fixture, occupancy sensors, microprocessor based chillers etc. has also proposed.

- (ix). As per Rule no. 84 Table 1.3 of MPBVR 2012 the required car parking is 342 ECS. PP has proposed to provide 416 ECS (Basement-1 area 7290.0 sq.m.& basement-2 area 7290.0).
- (x). PP has proposed an area of 2556.00 to be developed as green area including 130 no. of trees. PP has reported that 12 nos. of trees already exist in the project site which is proposed to be cut as per Municipal Corporation Bhopal permission (letter dtd.02.02.18).
- (xi). CSR implementation budget would be approximately 2% of the annual average profit of the project.
- (xii). PP has proposed to achieve Platinum precertification from Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) under the IGBC Green Homes Rating.
- (xiii). Total cost of the project is estimated as Rs. 10500 Lakhs.
- (xiv). Benefit of the project- The project involves the Construction of 4/5 Star hotel and Convention Center with 220 Rooms, Convention / banquet facilities of 2700 sqm. (Indoor and Outdoor space), meeting rooms, executive lounge and business center, restaurants (4 nos.), health club & Spa. Project will provide 334 Nos employment potential.

The Authority decided to accept the recommendations of 306<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 27.01.2018 with 35 special conditions and accord Prior Environment Clearance for proposed Construction of 4/5 Star Hotel and Convention Center on Khasra No. 40/3 & 276/3 at Village - Kotra Sultanabad, Dist. Bhopal, MP. Total Plot Area – 16194.0 sq.m. Proposed built-up area- 45828.0 sq. m, by M/s Genex Hotel Pvt. Ltd. Mr. Bharat Singh, POA holder Green Wood Country Club Parisar, Van Vihar Road, Bhopal, MP - 462003 subject to following Specific Conditions as recommended by SEIAA its meetings.

(1) The entire demand of fresh water should be met through Nagar Nigam supply and there should be no extraction of ground water.

#### (2) Waste water:

- a) PP should ensure zero discharge of waste water from the project site.
- b) PP should ensure that the discharge of extra treated waste water (if any) is linked with the proposed municipal sewer line.
- PP should ensure regular monitoring of treated waste water so as to confirm to the prescribed norms MPPCB/ CPCB.

#### (3) Natural Drainage:

a) The inlet and outlet point of natural drain system should be maintained with adequate size of channel for ensuring unrestricted flow of water.

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b) No construction shall allow obstructing the natural drainage through the site; Building shall be designed to follow the natural topography as much as possible. Minimum cutting and filling should be done.

#### (4) Municipal Solid Waste:

- (a) Provide compactors for MSW
- (b) Ensure three bin systems for segregated collection of waste.
- (c) Separate wet and dry bins must be provided at the ground level for facilitating segregation of waste.
- (d) All non-biodegradable waste shall be handed over to authorized recyclers for which a written tie up must be done with the authorized recyclers.
- (e) Ensure linkage with Municipal Corporation for final disposal of MSW.

#### (5) Energy:-

- (a) All common area/open area and green area lighting must be of LED/Solar lights.
- (b) At least 1% of connected applied load generated from renewable energy source such as photovoltaic cells or wind mills or hybrid be provided.
- (c) Fly ash bricks should be used as building material in the construction as per the provisions of Fly Ash Notification of September, 1999 and as amended from time to time.
- (6) PP should ensure the rain water harvesting by providing 02 nos of recharging pits. In addition, PP should provide recharging trenches. The base of the trenches should be Kachha with pebbles.
- (7) Installation of dual pipe plumbing for supplying fresh water for drinking, bathing etc and other for supply of recycled water for flushing, landscape, washing etc. shall be done.
- (8) Use of water saving devices/fixtures (viz. low flow flushing systems, use of low flow faucets tap aerators etc) for water conservation shall be incorporated in the building plan.
- (9) PP should ensure to provide the car parking as proposed 416 ECS Basement-1 area 7290.0 sq.m.& basement-2 area 7290.0)

### (10) Traffic management:-

- (a) PP should ensure road width, front MOS and side / rear as per MPBVR 2012.
- (b) The roads inside the project area and roads connected to the main road shall be paved or shall be water sprinkled to avoid the fugitive emissions during construction.
- (c) Traffic congestion near the entry and exit points from the roads adjoining the proposed project site shall be avoided.
- (d) No public space including the service road shall be used or blocked for the parking and the trained staff shall be deployed to guide the visitors for parking and helping the senior citizens and physically challenged people to park their vehicles at appropriate parking places (valet parking).

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### (11) Fire Fighting Management:

- (a) As per MPBVR, 2012 rule 42 (3) PP should submit necessary drawings and details to the Authority (Nagar Nigam, Indore) incorporating all the fire fighting measures recommended in National Building Code part – IV point no. 3.4.6.1. The occupancy permit shall be issued by Nagar Nigam only after ensuring that all fire fighting measures are physically in place.
- (b) PP should ensure connectivity to the fire station from the project site and provide all necessary arrangements of firefighting as per fire fighting NOC issued by Municipal Corporation Bhopal dtd. 12.01.18.
- (c) Dedicated power back up system shall be provided in the case of power failure & emergency of fire water pumps.
- (d) All the staircases and lifts shall open out at ground level from the highest point of building with access from each floor for emergency evacuation. Two staircases shall be provided in each building.
- (e) Sufficient peripheral open passage shall be kept in the margin area for free movement of fire tender/ emergency vehicle around the premises.

#### (12) Air Quality and Noise:

- (a) Dust, smoke & debris prevention measures such as wheel washing, screens, barricading & debris chute shall be installed at the site during construction including plastic/tarpaulin sheet covers for trucks bringing in sand & material at the site.
- (b) The exhaust pipe of the DG set if installed must be minimum of 10mtr away from the building or incase it is less than 10m away, the exhaust pipe shall be taken up to 3m above the building.

#### (13) Green belt:

- (a) PP should ensure two rows peripheral plantation at a distance of 3 to 5 m. of tree species (2 mt. high plants) all around the property area.
- (b) PP should ensure to initiate plantation in the project site during construction.
- (c) PP should ensure plantation of the trees of indigenous local varieties like Neem, Peepal, Kadam, Karanj, Kachnaar etc along with ornamental varieties.
- (d) Every effort should be made to protect the existing trees on the site. PP has proposed 12 trees will be cut after obtaining statutory permission from the Competent Authority. They will also compensate additional plantation due to cutting of these 12 trees as per the regulations.
- (14) PP should ensure implementation of CSR Activities in consultation with the District Administration, Bhopal and accordingly make budget provision for the same.
- (15) Since upper lake is located near to the project site, hence within 50 m from the Full Reservoir Level (FRL) of Upper Lake will be demarcated as no construction zone and no construction activity will be permitted in this zone.

The Facility includes Incinerator, Autoclave, Shredder, Boiler and Effluent Treatment Plant.
  - (2) The proposed capacity 500 kg per hour rotary kiln based bio medical incineration includes: .
    - a. Incinerator 02 500 Kg/hr(250 Kg/hr Each)
    - b. Autoclave 04 200kg/hr(50kg/hr Each)

  - (3) The proposed project is for setting up of common bio-medical waste treatment facility and project falls under Category "B" Projects of activity 7 (da) as per EIA Notification dated 14th September, 2006 and its subsequent amendments dated 17<sup>th</sup> April 2015, under Bio- Medical Waste Treatment Facilities.
  - (4) The project site is located industrial plot of M. P. Audyogik Kendra Vikas Nigam Mandideep (M.P. AKVN). #### Phase - 2:

- · Laundry equipment with a capacity of 4000 kg/day.
- Boiler for the laundry.
- Associated Utilities & Amenities.

#### Phase - 3:

- Laundry of capacity 3000 kg/day.
- · Boiler for the laundry.
- · Associated Utilities & Amenities.

#### Phase - 4:

- Laundry of capacity 3000 kg/day with a total capacity of 10000 kg/day (Including Phase – 2, 3 and 4)

#### Phase - 5:

- Incinerator of capacity 250 kg/hr.making total incineration capacity as 3285 MT per year including phase I and V.

- (ii) The project site is industrial plot having an area of 2.0006 ha. land is on lease by M. P. Audyogik Kendra Vikas Nigam Mandideep (M.P. AKVN) to M/s India Waste Management Pvt. Ltd. out of which only 7220.88 Sq.M will be utilized for Proposed Project. - (iv) Approximately 200 KLD water effluents shall be generated from all sources such as Laundry, Floor Washing, Vehicle/ Container Washing etc. and the same shall be treated in ETP and after treatment the treated water shall be recycled and reused Waste water generated during the CBWTF's operation will be reused in vehicle washing/ for irrigation in green belt.
- (v) PP has proposed 2 separate ETP for Laundry & incinerator with 300 KLD (100+200) where the available treated water will be separately 100 % reutilized in process & landscaping purposes without using of ME and RO. No treated wastewater shall be let out of the premises of the CBWTF.
- (vi) The odor management is one the issue in CBWTF. PP has proposed the mitigation measures to minimize and control odor are as follows.
  - a. Wash waste collecting vehicles, containers and store rooms frequently.
  - b. Treatment of bio-medical wastes within 48 hours.
  - Closed cabin vehicles shall be used for the collection and transportation of bio-medical wastes.
  - d. Mask shall be provided to workers to avoid health issues due to odour.
  - e. Enough green belt will be developed
- (vii) The expected air pollution sources are DG set, Incinerator, Boiler and Line sources from vehicular emissions. For control of air pollution PP has proposed following:-

- Effective stack height (as per the norms of CPCB) will be provided.
- Low sulphur content fuel (HSD) will be used to contain the emissions within the permissible norms.
- Effective Air Pollution Control Devices\* will be installed to contain the emissions within the permissible standards.
- DG sets will be used in case of power cuts/ failures only and in no case the unit will depend on DG sets as main source of power.
- PUC certified vehicles will be used.
- Idling of the vehicles especially during unloading will be avoided.
- Effective Green Belt (33%) to contain emissions.
- (viii) Collection, transportation, storage & treatment of Bio Medical Waste as stipulated in Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and CPCB Guidelines for installation of Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment Facility. For Collection and Transportation of Bio medical Waste PP has proposed to provide following as per BMW Management Rules, 2016:-

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- Around 15 transport vehicles will be dedicated and have adopted conditions specified in BMW Management Rules, 2016.
- Collection and transportation activities will be carried out with minimal/zero hazard to human health and environment.
- Proper care will be taken to ensure that segregated BMW handed over by HCEs reach CBWTF without any damage, spillage or unauthorized access.
- · Vehicles will not be used for any other purpose. Every time a vehicle is unloaded, the vehicle and empty waste containers are washed and properly disinfected.
- (ix) For solid waste PP has proposed to send all the incineration ash at common hazardous waste treatment and disposal facility (TSDF). Ash from Incineration and Sludge from Effluent Treatment Plant shall be disposed off in nearest TSDF through authorized vendor/recyclers.

PP has proposed depending on the category/nature disposal of all the generated hazardous waste as per Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 and Bio medical waste as per Management and Handling)Rules, 2016. No landfill site in the project. Only ash will be generated from incinerator and this will be disposed as per MoU with TSDF unit

- (x) PP has proposed As per BMW Rules 2016, HCEs are required to phase out use of chlorinated plastic bags, gloves and blood bags within two years, the facility utilizes non-chlorinated plastic colored bags only and wastes to be incinerated shall not be chemically treated with any chlorinated disinfectants However, Steps are taken to prevent reformation of dioxins by rapidly lowering the flue gas temperatures, particularly from 500° C to less than 200° C by adopting rapid quenching.
- (xi) For fire fighting and disaster management, PP has proposed to provide firefighting equipment at appropriate locations (sand bags, fire extinguishers etc.) to carry out monitoring of incinerator operating parameters and proper roofing/flooring/building materials to withstand heat etc.
- (xii) The power requirement of the project is 1000KVA. The source of electricity is Madhya Pradesh Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company Limited. PP has also provided power back up by DG set capacity of 500 KVA.
- (xiii) PP has proposed to develop green belt area in 1875.15 sq m. by planting 320 numbers of trees. Plantation around project site need to be done in 3 lines i.e. first line of only flowering herbs/shrub, second line should be of shrub/hedge in close spacing and along the road of project site a row of small trees. The planting cost of 320 saplings @ Rs. 250 works out for Rs. 0.80 lakhs.

(xiv) PP has proposed funds to the extent of 2% of the annual profit for CSR activities by including Safe Drinking Water Facility & Sanitation, Health Care Facility, Health Camps, Waste Segregation Awareness Programmes, Promoting Education, Development of village schools, Plantation, Park / Playground, Sports etc.

During persual of the case It was observed by the committee a complaint letter received from Prof Dr. Subhas C. Pandey & Mohd Tahir Khan for Issues related to establishment of a New CBWTF at Village - Mandideep Tehsil - Goharganj, District -Raisen (M.P) against the Guide line of CBWTF. In the said complaint it was mentioned that a new CBWTF is being developed at in Industrial area Mandideep M.P. which comes within 75 km distance from the existing CBWTF which is violation of the BMW Rules of 2016. As per revised guideline of CPCB-2016 for Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facilities shall be allowed to cater healthcare unit at a radial distance of 75 km, where 10000 beds are not available in coverage area. In case number of beds is exceeding >10000 beds in a locality and existing treatment capacities is not adequate in such a case new CBWTF may be allowed in such a locality in compliance to various provisions notified under EPA-1986 to cater services only to such additional bed strength of the HCFs located. At present there are more than 22000 beds are available within 75 Km in different nursing home and already two incinerators are operated within this circumstances. As per norms after exceeding 30000 bed a another new CBWTF may be allowed in such a locality.

After deliberation it was decided to ask PP to furnish following information:

- Gap analysis study report to justify the establishment of a new CBWTF in Mandideep industrial area within 75 km radius of other CBWTF.
- Clear NOC from the AKVN regarding water supply as PP has applied to AKVN for supply of water for the project.
- MOU for disposal of hazardous waste in TSDF site.
- Storm Water management plan.
- · Plan of CSR activities with budget provision.

Since the matter is sub-judicious in Hon'ble NGT (CZ) hence, MP Pollution Control Board may be asked to submit factual site visit report for suitability of site as per directives of Hon'ble NGT order dated 17.04.2017 and report on CTE issued by Board on BMW Rules – 2016 of CPCB considering the present scenario of already existed CBWTF within 75 km radius and bed capacity.

- IV. The mining operation shall be restricted to above ground water table and in no case it should intersect the ground water table. In case of working below the ground water table approval of the Central Ground Water Board shall be obtained.
- PP will plant 3 years old 1295 trees saplings of suitable indigenous tree species in 3500sq m + 1400m Road side barrier zone during first year.
- VI. The over burden and waste will be stacked for five years and then simultaneously backfilled in the mined out area where plantation will be raised on it.
- VII. No overburden will be dumped outside the mine lease area.
- VIII. Regular air & water quality monitoring shall be carried out by PP before discharging it into the nearby agriculture fields from authorized laboratory in consultation with Regional Officer, MPPCB.
  - IX. PP shall ensure generation of employment opportunities to nearby Village on priority bases.
  - Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labour laws.
  - XI. Proper infrastructure with shelter, drinking water, toilet and first-aid facilities shall be provided for the laborers. A provision should be made

- XVI. PP shall ensure proper implementation of plantation, dust suppression, construction of approach road and maintenance of existing pakka road as part of Environmental Management Plan. Additional budget provision shall be made as part of EMP.
- XVII. PP must ensure implementation of the following activities. Separate budget provision should be kept under CSR.
  - a) Providing Computer in the Higher Secondary School in Village Katangjhari, Pipariya along with instructor.
  - b) Medical checkup facility shall be carried out at nearby villages.
  - Skill development centre established at Katangjhari for youth, woman's & girls.

The modification to the above activities can be made with the permission of the district administration and need based activity for the development of nearby villages shall be implemented by PP in consultation with the District Collector and Grampanchayat.

XVIII. PP should ensure to submit half yearly compliance report and CSR activity report with photographs of plantation in MP-SEIAA.
