Neemuch (MP) by Shri Shreelal Aanjana, S/o Shri Jorji Aanjana, R/o Aanjana Complex, Tagore Marg, Tehsil & District - Neemuch, MP




"PP may be asked to deposit the bank gurantee (BG) of Rs.12,59,500/- (equivalent to amount proposed in remediation and resource augmentation plan) with the MP Pollution control Board after approval of the SEIAA as per the procedure laid down in the MoEF&CC Notification dated 08/03/2018"


After detail discussion, it has been decided that the case will <sup>be</sup> considered for Prior EC after the deposition of the bank guarantee of Rs.12,59,500/- (equivalent to amount proposed in remediation and resource augmentation plan) to MP Pollution control Board as recommended by SEAC.

2. **Case No. 5534/17** Prior Environment Clearance for **Bauxite, Laterite and Fireclay Mine** (opencast other than fully mechanized method) in an area of 3.417 ha. for production capacity of 25000 TPA at Khasra no. 609, 610/1, 610/2 at Village- Naikin , Tehsil - Rampur Naikin, Dist. Sidhi (MP) by Shri Krishnadas Tikaram, Civil Line, District Katni, MP-483501.

- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of **Bauxite, Laterite and Fireclay Mine** in MLA of 3.417 ha .The activity is mentioned at S.No. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National park and sanctuary is 9.750 km. etc. thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1' by virtue of its location and mining lease area. 





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SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease period upto 25.02.2027 with production capacity of 25000 TPA. The Mining Plan was approved by IBM (MP/Sidhi/Bauxite/M.sch-53/2014-15/382 dated 29-01-2015).

- (2) PP has produced an order of the Mineral Resources Deptt. GoMP dtd. 03.09.2015 in which after hearing the case the State Govt. has established that action be taken according to the latest circular 19-5-2015/12/1 dtd. 12.03.2015, which states that "all mining leases granted before the commencement of the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Amendment Ordinance 2015 shall be deemed to have been granted for a period of fifty years.
- (3) SEAC in its 330th SEAC meeting dtd. 21.10.2018 has recommended the case with 34 special conditions for issuance of EC.
- (4) The case was then discussed in 508<sup>th</sup> SEIAA meeting dtd. 15.11.2018 and PP/Consultant was invited for presentation. Thereafter, PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail.
- (5) It was noted that the water requirement is 12 KLD (Dust Suppression – 4 KLD + Green Belt – 6 KLD + Drinking/Domestic purpose 2 KLD), which shall be met from mine query and old bore well.
- (6) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that 3420 trees shall be planted (Barrier Zone and backfilled area) in an area of 1.024 ha during the lease period.
- (1) It was noted that the Public Hearing was held on 22.05.2018 at mine site, Village - Naikin, Tehsil - Ra, [ir Maolom, Dist. - Sidhi (MP) under the Chairmanship of ADM, Sidhi. The issues raised during public hearing were of general nature and nothing adverse was found regarding degradation of the environment.
- (2) After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 323<sup>rd</sup> SEAC meeting dtd. 18.08.2018, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA & SEAC, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project **subject to the following specific conditions:-**
  - I. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
  - II. Lease agreement shall be carried out before execution of mining operation.
  - III. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as "no mining zone" in the periphery of mining lease area and developed a green belt.
  - IV. Plantation programme as mentioned in EIA/EMP and presented during presentation in SEIAA & SEAC shall be followed in content and spirit.








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- V. The mining operation shall be restricted to above ground water table and in no case it should intersect the ground water table. In case of working below the ground water table approval of the Central Ground Water Board shall be obtained.
- VI. PP will plant 3 years old 1534 saplings of suitable indigenous tree species during first year with indigenous local varieties like Neem, Peepal, Kadam, Karnj, Kachnaar etc. and plantation of 2203 trees along the both side transportation route during first year.
- VII. PP should construct the Pakka road of 650 m from mine site to the ~~Birsinghpur Satna~~ road outer side the village area and maintain it on regular basis in consultation with District Administration. Plantation will be carried out on both side of approach road.
- VIII. Transportation of minerals shall not be carried out inside the village area.
- IX. PP ensure that blasting will be carried out as per approved mine plan and blasting not allowed in night hours.
- X. PP shall ensure that the mine waste water should not be discharge outside the mining lease area and may re-used in the mining activities.
- XI. No overburden will be dumped outside the mine lease area.
- XII. The over burden and waste will be stacked for five years and then simultaneously backfilled in the mined out area where plantation will be raised on it.
- XIII. PP shall ensure protection and conservation of existing trees falling under mining lease area and in no way these will be permitted to be cut / uprooted
- XIV. PP shall ensure generation of employment opportunities to nearby Village on priority bases.
- XV. Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labour laws.
- XVI. Proper infrastructure with shelter, drinking water, toilet and first-aid facilities shall be provided for the laborers. A provision should be made to construct a pakka rest shelter along with toilet and drinking water facility.
- XVII. PP should also carry out regular sprinkling in the mining lease area to arrest dust emission from mining activities affecting the nearby agriculture fields
- XVIII. Mining shall be limited to the area as shown in surface plan and as per the approved mining scheme.
- XIX. PP shall ensure the proper water supply arrangements for plantation especially in summer season.
- XX. Under CSR activity in addition to the proposed activities following activities should be added.
- a) Hand pumps installation water supply system at nearby villages.
- b) Environment sustainability.

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- c) Promotion of poor child education in nearby Govt. Schools at Naikin and nearby villages.
- d) Health care facilities camp with doctor in village Naikin and nearby villages.

**The modification to the above activities can be made with the permission of the district administration and need based activity for the development of nearby villages shall be implemented by PP in consultation with the District Administration and Gram Panchayat.**

- XXI. PP should ensure to submit half yearly compliance report and CSR activity report with photographs of plantation in MP-SEIAA.

**Hence, Prior Environmental Clearance is accorded for Bauxite, Laterite and Fireclay Mine (opencast other than fully mechanized method) in an area of 3.417 ha. for production capacity of 25000 TPA at Khasra no. 609, 610/1, 610/2 at Village- Naikin , Tehsil - Rampur Naikin, Dist. Sidhi (MP) for the lease period to Shri Krishnadas Tikaram, Civil Line, District Katni, MP-483501.**


3. **Case No 5683/2018** Prior Environment Clearance for **Stone Quarry** in an area of 6.07 Ha. (375000 TPA) (Khasra no. 498/26) at Village- Gada, Tehsil - Hanumana, Dist. Rewa by Shri Umesh Kumar Singh, Flat No. 301, Gangotri Apartment, Jawahar Nagar, Gurudham, Varanasi, UP - 221005


**EC granted in 494 SEIAA meeting dated 12-07-18 for production capacity of 150000 cum/year vide letter No 1197/SEIAA/18 dated 25.07.18. PP vide letter dated 10.08.18 has requested to rectify the proction capacity 150000 cum/year or 375000 TPA as per Form -1. After examining the record in Form -1 and PFR submitted by PP, it has been decided to rectify production capacity as 150000 cum/year or 375000 TPA in prior EC considering bulk density 2.5. Accordingly, rectification letter can be issued to PP with copy to all concerned.**


4. **Case No. 1300/2013-** Prior Environmental Clearance for Stone/ Boulder Quarry (Opencast manual / semi mechanised method) in an area of 1.0 ha. for production capacity of 8000 cum/year (as per SEAC recommendation) at khasra no.395 at Village Dungaria, Tehsil.-Bohriband , District- Katni M.P by Shri Gyanendra Singh, S/o Shri Munshiram, Village.-Dungaria, Tehsil.-Bohriband, District-Katni (M.P.) 483440 - **Regarding transfer of EC in the name of M/s Khajuraho Stones (India). Pvt. Ltd. Post box no. 32 District Chhatarpur - 471001 M.P.**

- (1) It was noted that the PP had applied in **Form-I** for Prior Environmental Clearance of **Stone/ Boulder Quarry** (Opencast manual/semi mechanized method) in an area of 1.00 ha. for production capacity of 8000 cum/year (as per SEAC recommendation) at khasra no.395 at Village Dungaria, Tehsil.-Bohriband , District- Katni M.P by Shri Gyanendra Singh, S/o Shri Munshiram, Village.-Dungaria, Tehsil.-Bohriband, District-Katni (M.P.) 483440

- i. The Prior Environmental Clearance letter was issued vide L.No. 3220 dated 22.01.2015 in the name of " **Shri Gyanendra Singh, S/o Shri Munshiram, Village.-Dungaria, Tehsil.-Bohriband, District-Katni (M.P.) 483440** ".

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- (2) It is noted that PP has requested vide no 833/K.S.(I)P.L./2018 Chhatarpur dtd. 25.10.2018 to make amendment in the Prior EC letter by changing the name of PP of the mining project namely "**M/s Khajuraho Stones (India). Pvt. Ltd** " **Post box no. 32 District Chhatarpur - 471001 M.P.** in place of "**Shri Gyanendra Singh, S/o Shri Munshiram, Village.-Dungaria, Tehsil.-Bohriband, District-Katni (M.P.) 483440**".
- (3) It is noted that in support of his request the PP has submitted the following documents

- (4) It is noted that in EIA Notification 2006 as per **Para-11 Transferability of Environmental Clearance (EC)** there is a provision of transferring the EC.


**Para-11 :-** *A prior environmental clearance granted for a specific project or activity to an applicant may be transferred during its validity to another legal person entitled to undertake the project or activity on application by the transferor, or by the transferee with a written "no objection" by the transferor, to, and by the regulatory authority concerned, on the same terms and conditions under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted, and for the same validity period. No reference to the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned is necessary in such cases.*


In context of above it seems that PP has submitted adequate documents to make the change in the name of PP as per EIA Notification 2006 (Para-11). Hence, prior EC issued in the name of "**Shri Gyanendra Singh, S/o Shri Munshiram, Village.-Dungaria, Tehsil.-Bohriband, District-Katni (M.P.) 483440** " is hereby transferred to "**M/s Khajuraho Stones (India). Pvt. Ltd Post box no. 32 District Chhatarpur - 471001 M.P.**for Stone/ Boulder Quarry in an area of 1.0 ha for production capacity of 8000 cum/year (as per SEAC recommendation) at khasra no.395 at Village Dungaria, Tehsil.-Bohriband , District- Katni M.P. " on the same terms & conditions and validity period under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted. **All concerned be informed accordingly.**

5. **Case No.1728/2013:** Applied for Amendment in Environment Clearance for Vikram Udyogpuri, Ujjain under Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (DMICDC) at village Narvar, Karchha, Munjakhedi, Gawdi, Piplodhwar, Dwarkadhish, Madhupur, Tehsil & District Ujjain (MP); Built up Area – 4105941 sq.m.; proposed Total Area to be Developed Approximately – 442.26 ha. by Managing Director DMIC.

- The Prior Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification, 2006 has been issued for the development of industrial state Vikram Udyogpuri, Ujjain under Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (DMICDC) at village Narvar, Karchha, Munjakhedi, Gawdi, Piplodhwar, Dwarkadhish, Madhupur, Tehsil &

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District Ujjain (MP) to Mr. D. S. Chaturvedi, Managing Director, M.P. Audyogik Vikas Nigam (Ujjain ) Ltd.( MP AKVN) Nana Kheda Bus Stand Campus, Indore Road, Ujjain, MP (PP) vide letter no. 7263 dtd 05.11.15.

- The Proponent (vide letter dtd 26.11.18 received in SEIAA office on 01.12.2018) has requested to include establishment of Auto ancillary unit, Food processing IT, logistic hub, Chemical Pharma and Dairy products etc in DMIC VUL and issue revised Environmental Clearance accordingly. The matter was discussed in detail and it is decided that as per specific condition pt. no. 14 & 17 of EC letter (dtd.05.11.15) **"Since Category A or B projects of the schedule of EIA Notification, 2006 are not part of the proposed project however in future any Cat-A/B industry if proposed in the industrial area will be required to obtain prior EC"** hence it should be ensured that these projects are not allowed in the said industrial area without prior EC.
- As per the provisions of EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments Expansion or modernization in the project, entailing capacity/ built-up area/ project area, addition with change in process and or technology and any change in product - mix in proposed project shall require a fresh Environment Clearance.

Considering above, PP may ask to submit afresh application for prior EC for change of above scope / products as per EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments. Accordingly PP and other concerned may be informed.


6. **Case No. 09/2008** Prior Environment Clearance for **Clay, Ochre & Laterite Mines** in an area of 15.30 Ha. for production capacity of 14,000 TPA at Village, Tehsil Khomarha, Amarpatan, District Satna by M/s K I Agrawal, V.P.O. Jaithwara, Satna – 485221, M.P.


EC was granted to M/s K I Agrawal vide letter No. 1268/SEIAA/12 dated 9.10.12 for mining lease period i.e. upto 20.7.18. PP has requested vide letter dated 9.11.18 by enclosing concerned documents to extend EC validity upto lease period i.e. 20.07.28. After discussion it is decided to call PP for clarification.


7. **Case No. 613/2010** Prior Environmental Clearance for expansion of dolomite & limestone mine (Open cast/Fully Mechanized method) in an area of 19.71 ha for enhancement of production capacity from 6660 TPA to 5,00,000 TPA at Khasra No. Part of 31 and 13 new at village Chhapparwah, Tehsil Badwara, District Katni M.P. by M/s Ultra Tech Cement Limited (Birla White Unit), D-7, Shastri Nagar Jodhpur (Rajsthan)-342003.

EC was granted upto life of mine i.e. for 6 year vide letter no. 1085-86/SEIAA/13 date 25-06-13. PP has submitted a request application vide letter no. UTCL/ KTE / BW / MIN dated 20.11.2018 received in SEIAA office dtd. 20.11.2018 regading extension of validity of Environmental Clearance upto mine life i.e. 31.03.30. After discussion, it is decided to call PP for clarification.
