


## Minutes of the 530<sup>th</sup> Meeting of SEIAA dated. 15.03.2019



As per the notification issued by MoEF&CC on 14.09.2006, the policy on transferability of EC is as follows:-

**11. Transferability of Environmental Clearance (EC):**

*A prior environmental clearance granted for a specific project or activity to an applicant may be transferred during its validity to another legal person entitled to undertake the project or activity on application by the transferor, or by the transferee with a written "no objection" by the transferor, to, and by the regulatory authority concerned, on the same terms and conditions under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted, and for the same validity period. No reference to the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned is necessary in such cases*

After detailed discussions on the MoEF&CC Notification regarding transferability and perusal of the above information, **it has been decided to transfer the Prior EC issued on 18.04.2016 in favour of Sarpanch Gram Panchayat, Hathnora, District-Gwalior in the place Shri Kailash Chandra Gupta, M/s Shiva Corporation India Pvt. 


The case was discussed in 523 SEIAA meeting dated 15-02-19 and it was recorded that:-


