


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
" The case was presented by the PP and their consultant wherein it was observed by the committee that on the southern side of the lease some excavation is done for which PP submitted that local villagers has dig out the soil from this area. It was further observed that a road is passing from the northern side of the lease which is approx. 75 meters away. PP submitted that this road is sufficiently away from the lease for which committee suggested that three rows plantation shall be carried out on the parts of the lease towards road side. Committee observed that there is small depression on the south eastern side of the lease which appears to be a natural drain/ water flow channel during rainy season and thus instructed that the part of the natural drain shall not be disturbed and remain unchanged as non mining area and three row plantations shall be carried out at this side. The EMP and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'A'."

PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail. **After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 351st SEAC meeting dated 16.03.2019, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:-**




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
- II. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. Three row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement
- III. PP shall plant 1214 saplings of Neem, Sisoo, Mango and Kachnar in green belt in area 1.214 ha. in mining area, Village area and approach road.
- IV. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.




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
" The case was presented by the Pp and their consultant wherein it was observed by the committee that a road is passing from the eastern side of the lease which is approx. 30 meters away. Pp submitted that this road is sufficiently away from the lease for which committee suggested that three rows plantation shall be carried out on the parts of the lease towards road side and a setback of 30 meters shall also be left as non-mining area. Committee further observed that a crusher is installed in the lease for which PP submitted that they have installed the crushed with the consent of the MP Pollution Control Board but have not carry out any mining operations on this lease which is also evident from the Google image as no mined out area is visible and stones for crushing were brought from their other leases. (PP provided the copies of the consent obtained from the MPPCB vide letter dated 16/03/2019) Committee observed that the crushed is located 50 meters away from the lease thus crusher shall be relocated and installed minimum 100 meters away from the road. The EMP and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'A'."

PP submitted that this road is sufficiently away from the lease for which committee suggested that three rows plantation shall be carried out on the parts of the lease towards road side. Committee further observed that a crusher is installed outside the lease on the northern side for which PP submitted that this crusher does not belongs to us, however, some soil is excavated by the local villagers from their lease on the western side. 
" The case was presented by the PP and their consultant. During presentation committee observed in the Google image that some part of the lease is submerged in water. Committee further observed that the demanded volume of the sand can be evacuated from the rest dried ML area as the area submerged in water is considered as non mining area in mine plan. After presentation the committee asked to submit following details:


- *Revised EMP for Occupational Health check- up, PPE's, First Aid, Fire fighting, shelters & toilet for workers.*
- *Revised plantation as suggested during presentation.*
- *Revised CSR (add distribution of filters, solar lights, books, and smart classes in nearby schools) as suggested during presentation.*


Vide letter dated 01.03.2019, PP has submitted the desired information, which was placed before the committee. After deliberations, the EMP and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'B'."

PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail. **After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 348th SEAC meeting dated 01.03.2019, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:-**


- (i). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity approved by SEAC.






This case was recommended in 353rd SEAC meeting dated 19.03.2019 and it was recorded that.....


"..... PP has submitted the response of above quarries same date vide letter dated 19.03.2019, which was placed before the committee and the same found satisfactory. The EMP and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee after deliberation found that The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'C'."

PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail. **After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 353rd SEAC meeting dated 19.03.2019, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:-**

- (i). The production capacity shall be limited to the quantity approved by SEAC.
- (ii). No in-stream mining shall be allowed.
- (iii). The depth of the pit as per Approved Mining Plan.
- (iv). No in-stream mining shall be allowed. No ramp will be allowed within the river basin to transport sand to the other bank. Transportation will be allowed on the bank side where the mineral is being excavated.
- (v). The entire lease area should be properly fenced and boundary stones marked at the site.
- (vi). Transportation from the dense populated area will be avoided as committed by PP.
- (vii). Plantation shall be raised both side of the approach road with tree guard. Plantation of Neem, Karanj, Mango, Amaltas, Kachnar, Drumstick, Amla and Peepal plants on priority shall be ensured by PP.
- (viii). A total of 1000 plants shall be planted along the lease boundary in mine premises and river bank, transportation route and around habitation.
- (ix). Water sprinkling will be done on the approach road on the regular basis.
- (x). PP shall ensure to conduct following CSR and Labour Welfare activities as committed under the budget provision of Rs. 1.00 lakh.
 - a) Education for children and old people of nearby villages (Smart Class & Library).
 - b) Regular Health Camps for nearby villagers.
 - c) Sanitary facilities & shelter for mine workers.


The case was discussed in 531st SEIAA meeting dated 18.03.19 and it was recorded that -


"As per recommendation of SEAC it was observed by the committee that the earthwork (digging and excavation) has been done by the project proponent prior to the environment clearance. Excavated stone boulders in large number and big size were found dumped along the road near the project site.


Hence it is decided that PP should prepare revised Environment management plan by the accredited consultants, incorporating the assessment of ecological damage, preparation of remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan and SEAC examine the EMP and finalise the the bank guarantee against the ecological damage of the environment for its remediation. The project proponent will be required to submit a bank guarantee equivalent to the amount of remediation plan and Natural and Community Resource Augmentation Plan to the MPPCB as per recommended by SEAC. The amount shall be deposited prior to the grant of environmental clearance and released after successful implementation of the remediation plan and Natural and Community Resource Augmentation Plan, and after recommendation by SEAC"

As per above decision, PP has submitted EMP incorporating remediation plan and natural & community resource augmentation plan with estimated cost on 5.04.2019. After deliberation, it is decided to send the above EMP to SEAC alongwith technical file for examination and appraisal the case.
