PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail. **After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 350th SEAC meeting dated 15.03.19, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:-**

- I. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
- II. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. Three row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement

"Case was presented in the 316th SEAC meeting dated 19/06/2018 and queries were raised for which PP was asked to submit response. Letter was issued to PP for submission of desired information vide letter no. 217 dated 10/07/2018. Reminders were also issued vide letter no. 248 dated 07/09/2018, 351 dated 19/11/2018. PP vide letter dated 13/12/2018 (forwarded by SEIAA vide letter dated 31/12/2018) has requested for grant of extension period for submission of information till 31/12/2018, but till date the desired information is still awaited.





- Vide letter dtd. 19.03.19 received in SEIAA office 29.03.19 PP has informed that implementation of blending of Ethanol (Class A) with MS is being followed up by Govt. Of India since Ehanol is a Bio-fuel and environment friendly. As per norms of Govt. of India to step up the construction of Ethanol storage facilities at all POL locations immediately, to ensure un-interrupted supply of Ehanol blended MS to consumers.
- In view of the above direction from Govt. of India PP needs to construct 4x200 capacity underground storage tank at Ratlam Terminal by reducing 800 KL and requested that there will not be any increase in production and pollution load hence consider the matter as per MoEF & CC Notification dtd. 23.11.2016.

On the request of PP, the matter was discussed before the committee and decided to send the case SEAC to examine the matter as per MoEF & CC Notification dtd. 23.11.2016.







Shri Rajesh Kumar Lade, Sub Lessee of MPSMCL (to whom prior EC was granted) has submitted letter in SEIAA Office on 25.02.2019 objecting not to transfer EC to Gram Panchayat or any one and has mentioned that false NOC was submitted to transfer EC in favour of Gram Panchayat. In this regard, a letter was written to M.P. State Mining Corporation vide No.92/SEIAA/2019 dated 3.4.2019 to clarify issue and give NOC for transfer of EC to Gram Panchayat, Suddi. In response to this, M.P. State Mining Corporation vide letter No. रेत /2019-2020/02 dated 4.4.2019 has given No Objection to transfer EC to Gram Panchayat, Suddi as per New Sand Mining Policy 2017.

SEIAA has also communicated Mr. Rajesh Kumar Lade vide letter No.93/SEIAA/2019 dated 3.4.2019 to personally present in SEIAA office and submit your stand/objection if any within 7 days from date of issue of above letter otherwise NOC given in affidavit will be accepted by authority for transfer of EC to Gram Panchayat, Suddi, Katni. But, Mr. Rajesh Kumar Lade has not submitted his stand/objection in SEIAA office in given time limit. Hence, it is decided to transfer prior EC in favour of Gram Panchayat, Suddi, Katni as per New Sand Mining Policy 2017 of State Govt.


As per the notification issued by MoEF&CC on 14.09.2006, the policy on transferability of EC is as follows:-


11. Transferability of Environmental Clearance (EC):


A prior environmental clearance granted for a specific project or activity to an applicant may be transferred during its validity to another legal person entitled to undertake the project or activity on application by the transferor, or by the transferee with a written "no objection" by the transferor, to, and by the regulatory authority concerned, on the same terms and conditions under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted, and for the same validity period. No reference to the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned is necessary in such cases

After detailed discussions on the MoEF&CC Notification regarding transferability and perusal of the above information, it has been decided to transfer the Prior EC issued on 03.08.2016 in favour of Sarpanch Gram Panchayat, Suddi, Katni in the place Shri Rajesh Kumar Lade, Sub Lessee of MPSMCL, New Kanchanpur, Aadhartal, District-Jabalpur (MP)-483773 for Sand Quarry in (Opencast Manual Method) in an area of 10.00 ha for production capacity of 40,000 cum/year (As per SEAC recommendation) at Khasra No.-1419 at Village-Suddi, Tehsil-Badwara, District-Katni on the same terms & conditions and validity period under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted. Copy to PP and all concerned.
