


- V. PP ensure that the proper water supply arrangements for dust suppression, regular sprinkling, plantation and drinking purposes especially in summer season.
- VI. PP shall ensure protection and conservation of existing trees falling under mining lease area and in no way these will be permitted to be cut / uprooted.
- VII. PP shall ensure to construct and maintained the approach road. Plantation will be carried out on both side of approach road.







- I. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements shall be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
- II. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. Three row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement
- III. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.

Panna (MP) for the lease period to Shri Pushpraj Singh S/o Shri Awadhraj Singh, R/o Kodar, Tehsil - Nagod, Dist. Satna, MP - 485551 .**

- 6. Case No.- 5607/2017 Prior Environmental Clearance for Bauxite, Laterite, Fireclay & Ochre Mine** (Open cast semi mechanized method) in an area of 16.188 ha. for production capacity (Total 248093 TPA) - (Bauxite - 161793 TPA, Laterite - 52952 TPA, Clay - 6466 TPA and Ochre - 26882 TPA) at Khasra no 49 at Vill. Rousra, Tehsil - Majhauri, Dist. Jabalpur, MP (MP) by M/s Hukum Chand Stone Lime Co., Nai Basti, Tehsil - Murwara, Dist. Katni, MP - 483501.

- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of Bauxite, Laterite, Fireclay & Ochre Mine in MLA of 16.188 ha. The activity is mentioned at S.No. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National Park /Sanctuary etc. thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1' by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease period upto 20.03.2035 with production capacity (Total 248093 TPA) - (Bauxite - 161793 TPA, Laterite - 52952 TPA, Clay - 6466 TPA and Ochre - 26882 TPA).
- (2) It was reported by the PP that the lease area was granted to M/s Hukum Chand Stone Lime Co., Nai Basti, Tehsil - Murwara, Dist. Katni, MP for 10 year period of w.e.f. 21.03.1985 to 20.03.1995 for mineral Bauxite and clay. The mineral Laterite and Red ochre were included in mine lease on 28/08/1986. The ML has been extended to 50 years in accordance with the MM (D&R) Amendment Act 2015 up to 21.03.2035. This is a case of New mining lease. The Mining Plan has been approved by IBM, Vide letter no. MP/Jabalpur/bauksite/ MPLN MOD-17/ 2016-17 dated 24.01.2017.
- (3) SEAC in its 357<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 01.04.2019 has recommended the case with 30 special conditions for issuance of EC.
- (4) It was noted that as per Forest Conservator L.No. 592 Jabalpur, dtd. 10.02.2012, the National Park/Sanctuary is not located within 10 Km., radius from the mining site. Hence, the General Conditions are not attracted. There is no forest boundary within 250m from mining site.







- (5) It was noted that the water requirement is 20 KLD (14 KLD Dust Suppression +3.0 KLD Green Belt + 3.0 KLD Domestic purpose) which shall be met from bore well / mine sump.
- (6) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that total 16122 sapling [11287 sapling of tree species covering an area of 11.2886 ha (backfilled area ) + 1835 sapling in an area of 1.8348 ha will be planted in green belt area + 3000 sapling at transport route] shall be covered under plantation.
- (7) It was also noted that the Public Hearing was carried out on 20.09.2018 at Mine Parisar Village- Rousra, Tehsil - Majhauri, Dist. Jabalpur under Chairmanship of Additional District Magistrate, Jabalpur. The major comments of applicants during public hearing are water for irrigation, access on approach road, Controlled blasting, employment of local people, construction & maintenance of existing / approach road connecting the mine & main road, Plantation on road side, regular health check-up of mine workers & water sprinkling to suppress the dust emission.

PP will plant 3 years old 2000 trees samplings of suitable indigenous fast grow tree species (neem, amla, peepal, drumstick, Karanj, Gulmohar, Mahua, Kachmar etc.) in barrier zone/no mining zone along the transportation route initially in current year. Plantation programme as mentioned in EIA/EMP and presented during presentation in SEIAA & SEAC shall be followed in content and spirit.
- VI. PP shall ensure to construct and maintain Pakka approach road from the mine site. Plantation will be carried out on both side of the approach road. PP shall also ensure maintenance of existing pakka road in consultation with competent authority.
- VII. The over burden and waste will be stacked for five years and then simultaneously backfilled in the mined out area where plantation will be raised on it.
- VIII. Toe wall will be constructed around the dump to avoid the rolling stones.


- IX. Regular air & water quality monitoring shall be carried out by PP before discharging it into the nearby agriculture fields from authorized laboratory in consultation with Regional Officer, MPPCB.
- X. PP shall ensure generation of employment opportunities nearby Village on priority bases.
- XI. Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labour laws.

  - c) Drinking water during summer season
  - d) Skill development programme to be conducted in village Rousara & Guna.



After deliberations, the EMP and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'A':"*

**After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 357<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dated 01.04.2019, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:-**

- XII. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements shall be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
- XIII. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. Three row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement
- XIV. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- XV. The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Revised Mining Plan.
