


Minutes of the 553rd Meeting of SEIAA dated. 08.06.2019




".....PP has submitted the response of above quarries same date vide letter dated 20.05.2019, which was placed before the committee and it was observed by the committee that PP in place of leaving 50 meters either side of the drain has proposed channelization of natural drain. Committee recommends that the natural drain shall not be disturbed and 50 meters area shall be left as non mining zone on the both sides of the lease and plantation shall be carried out in this area. The EMP and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee after deliberation found that The EMS and other submissions made by the PP were found to be satisfactory and acceptable, hence committee decided to recommend the case for grant of prior EC subject to the following special conditions in addition to the standard conditions at annexure 'A':

PP/Consultant made a presentation on all aspects of the project and all concerned issues were discussed in detail. **After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 370th SEAC meeting dated 20.05.19, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:-**

- I. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
- II. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. Three row plantations shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement.
- III. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
- IV. The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Revised Mining Plan.
- V. The mining operation shall be restricted to above ground water table and in no case it should intersect the ground water table. In case of working below the ground water table approval of the Central Ground Water Board shall be obtained.
- VI. Before execution of mining operation, PP shall ensure to construct chainling fencing toward forest area and leaving 150 m. as a no mining zone from forest boundary as recommended in Divisional Commissioner, Rewa meeting dated 05.03.2019.
- VII. Before commencing the mining activity, site demarcation should be done leaving 50 m. as a "no mining zone" from natural drain located out side the ML area and site demarcation should also be done leaving 50 m. upstream side & 20 m. downstream side as a "no mining zone" from the





Total 3500 saplings shall be planted by PP in first three years under plantation programme but PP should ensure to plant 3 years old saplings of suitable local tree species Lease boundary & approach road. Plantation of Pipal, Mahua, Amaltas, Bargad, Karanj, Neem, Behara, Ficus etc. will be planted on priority.
- IX. PP shall ensure to construct and maintained approach road. Plantation will be carried out on both side of approach road.
- X. Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labour laws.
- XI. Mining shall be limited to the area as shown in surface plan and as per the approved mining scheme.
- XII. PP shall ensure the proper water supply arrangements for dust suppression, regular sprinkling, plantation and drinking purposes especially in summer season.


This case was recommended in 374th SEAC meeting dated 25.05.2019 and it was recorded that.....

"..... The case with above details was placed before the committee. Committee observed that two complaints are made in this case one from Shri Afsar Khan, Shahdol vide letter dated 11/01/2018 and another through reporting's in news papers. The issue raised in the complaint made by Shri Afsar Khan are replied by Collector Umariya (forwarded by Sarpanch Balhod vide letter dated 11/04/2019) issued vide letter no. 265 dated 08/02/2019 which is self explanatory. However, for the reporting made in news papers for issues relating to the mining through machines, mining in mid stream etc are related to the compliance of EC conditions and certainly needs site verification as instructed by SEIAA. Committee after careful examination of the file recommends that primarily a verification/compliance report may be obtained from the Collector/Commissioner/Competent District Authority on the issues raised in the paper cutting/complaint. If the report is not conclusive and further inspection is required, a joint team comprising members from SEAC, District Authority, representative from MoEF&CC, SEIAA, Forest Department & Mining Department may be constituted to verify the compliance of EC conditions as in sand mining project identification of lease can be done by concerned district authority, issues related to forests can be addressed by Forest Department and EC compliance by MoEF&CC as PP has to submit 06 monthly compliance report.






