- III. The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Mining Plan.
- IV. PP shall leave 50 m from natural drain towards north-western direction as no mining zone.
- V. No overburden will be dumped outside the mine lease area.
- VI. PP shall ensure to construct appropriate size garland drain & settling tank all around the lease area

Dhar, MP – 454665, Stone Quarry in an area of 2.00 ha. (14,559 cum per annum) (Khasra No. 1/1), Village - Nindwaniya, Tehsil - Badnawar, Dist. Dhar (MP) are very close proximity/ overlapping with the actual lease which was showed by the PP. The PP was asked to submit revised Form -1 and accordingly revised coordinates in the mining plan duly verified by the competent authority and this case may be sent to SEIAA for delisting.

As per above recommendation of SEAC, it has been decided to delist the case on the condition that if PP intends to present the case in SEIAA, it will then be relisted for appraisal. Copy to PP and all concerned.

PP has requested vide letter dated 16.08.2019 to consider relisting the case. After considering the request of PP, case is relisted with direction to PP to submit revised Form -1 and revised coordinates in the mining plan duly verified by the competent authority to SEAC and decided to send the case to SEAC for appraisal.

"The case was presented by the PP and their consultant. During presentation PP was asked to submit lease agreement letter from the land owner. Further it was recorded as per Google image based on coordinates provided by PP that a water body exists at a distance of approx. 40 mts towards NE side of the lease, for that PP submits that it is not a notified water body and just an accumulation of water. Committee observed that even as per the old google image this water body is in existence since 2002 and as per the image of December, 2016, the water level is just 40 meters away. As per MMR, 1996, minimum 100 meters area is to be left from the water body and since the lease area is only of 1.00 ha if 50-60 meters is deducted from the lease, no workable area will be available. Thus committee after deliberations decided that on above ground case can not be recommended for grant of EC".


After detailed discussion and perusal of the recommendation of 220th SEAC meeting dtd. 26.08.2015, from the coordinate provided by the PP, a Village road bisects the proposed mining site. Collector, Singrauli should provide clarification as to how the mining lease has been granted in this given situation, where the approach road to the Village has been included for mining purposes. Copy to PP and Mining Officer, Singrauli.


The case was discussed in 320th SEIAA meeting dtd. 21.04.2016 and it is recorded that :-


