


## Minutes of the 571<sup>st</sup> Meeting of SEIAA dated. 17.09.2019






1. **Case No. 2416/2015** Prior Environmental Clearance for Laterite Mine (Open cast mechanized method) in an area of 13.284 ha. for expansion in production capacity from 1,837 TPA to 2,50,000 TPA at Khasra No. – 39/1 at Vill.-Sarwania Maharaj, Tehsil.-Neemuch, Distt.-Neemuch (M.P.) by Shri Sumit Singhania, 8, Shastri Nagar, Neemuch (M.P.)-458441

- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of Laterite Mine in MLA of 13.284 ha. The activity is mentioned at S.No. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National Park /Sanctuary etc. thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1' by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease period upto 31.03.2048 with expansion in production capacity from 1,837 TPA to 2,50,000 TPA.
- (2) This is a Mining Project comprising mining of Laterite in a lease area of 13.284 Ha. The mine is operational and now intends to enhance production from 1837 TPA to 250000 TPA. Initially, a prospecting licence was issued to Mr. Sanjay Kilewala by the Mineral Resources Department, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh vide letter No. 2-345/96/12/1 dated 30.12.1996 for a period of one year for exploring the presence of Laterite within an area of 13.284ha (Survey No. 39/1). The said license was executed on 30.01.1997. Subsequently, a mining lease over an area 13.284ha was granted to Mr. Sanjay Kilewala, by the Mineral Resources Department, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh vide letter No. 3-158/97/12/1 dated 25.03.1998 for a period of 20 years. The lease agreement was executed and registered on 01.04.1998.
- (3) Thereafter, the mining lease was transferred to Mr. Sumit Singhania on 03.07.2014, the terms and conditions of the lease remaining unchanged. The Scheme of Mining and Progressive mine Closure Plan for a targeted production of 2,50,000 TPA of Laterite mineral has been approved by the Director of Mineral Resources, Department Bhopal, vide letter No. 18225 dated 29.09.2017. Since, the mining lease area measures only 13.284 ha, the project falls under 'B1' category for which the Environmental Clearance (EC) is to be obtained from the SEIAA, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal. The necessary ToR was issued by the SEAC, Bhopal vide letter No. 432/PSMS/MPPCB/SEAC/TOR (191)/2015 dated 25.06.2015. The validity of mining lease was from 01.04.1998 to 31.03.2018. The extension in mining lease period was granted to Mr Sumit Singhania, up to 31.03.2048 by the Mining Officer, District Neemuch, Madhya Pradesh, vide letter No. 563/M.L. 10-98/mineral/2018 dated 21.03.2018 .
- (4) SEAC in its 370<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 20.05.2019 has recommended the case with 33 special conditions for issuance of EC.
- (5) It was noted that as per Forest Conservator L.No. 7760 Neemuch, dtd. 10.12.2014, the National Park/Sanctuary is not located within 10 Km., radius from the mining site. Hence, the General Conditions are not attracted.
- (6) It was noted that the water requirement is 3.50 KLD (0.50 KLD for Domestic + 1.5 KLD for Dust Suppression + 1.5 KLD for Green Belt which shall be met from mine pit & tube well.








- (7) The proposed plantation program was examined and it was found that total 4385 sapling in an area of 4.38 ha shall be covered under plantation.
- (8) It was also noted that the Public Hearing was carried out on 18.12.2015 at Mine Parisar Village Sarwania Maharaj, Th.--Neemuch, Distt.-Neemuch, under the Chairmanship of Upper Collector, Neemuch. The major comments of applicants during public hearing are water for irrigation, access on approach road, Controlled blasting, employment of local people, construction & maintenance of existing / approach road connecting the mine & main road, Plantation on road side, regular health check-up of mine workers & water sprinkling to suppress the dust emission.
- (9) SEAC in its 370<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 20.05.2019 during presentation, it was submitted by PP that it's a case of expansion however, no EC was obtained by PP thus no compliance report of earlier EC conditions is submitted and TOR considering the violation was issued. PP presented assessment of Ecological Damage cause and the Remedial Action Plan including Natural and Community Augmentation Plan .After presentation and discussion. PP has submitted the revised Natural & Community Augmentation Plan (NCA) which was placed before the committee. Committee observed that PP has revised the plan as follows:


*After review and detail discussion it was decided that the case will be consider after submission of the following information regarding DFO NOC for distance of ML area from the nearby forest boundary and copy of the bank guarantee of Rs. 9.55 lakh to MP Pollution control Board. Copy to PP.*


- (12) In response to above, PP has provided DFO letter and submitted Bank Gurantee of Rs. 9,55,000/- in SEIAA office vide letter dtd. 16.08.2019 which can be sent to MPPCB for depositing the same.

**After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 370<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 20.05.2019, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:**

- I. PP shall ensure to plant atleast 1000 saplings of suitable species in first six months and submit photographs of plantation in SEIAA office otherwise EC will be revoked.
- II. PP shall ensure to preserve thick greenery all around periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt.
- III. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
- IV. Plantation programme as mentioned in EIA/EMP and presented during presentation in SEIAA & SEAC shall be followed in content and spirit.
- V. Total 5640 saplings shall be planted by PP in five years under plantation programme but PP should ensure to plant 3 years old 877 saplings of suitable local tree species Lease boundary, approach road & transportation route initially within first year. Plantation of Pipal, Aam, Neem, Amla, Kachnar, Karanj, Jamun, Drum Stick, Jamun etc. will be planted on priority .
- VI. All garland drains shall be connected to settling tanks through settling pits and settled water shall be used for dust suppression, green belt development. Regular de-silting of drains and pits should be carried out
- VII. PP shall demarcate a barrier zone of 7.5 m as no mining zone in the periphery of mining lease area and develop a green belt. Three row plantation shall be carried out in the greenbelt area in current year with proper watering arrangement.
- VIII. The mining operation shall be restricted to above ground water table and in no case it should intersect the ground water table. In case of working below the ground water table approval of the Central Ground Water Board shall be obtained.
- IX. The over burden and waste will be stacked for five years and then simultaneously backfilled in the mined out area where plantation will be raised on it.
- X. No overburden will be dumped outside the mine lease area.
- XI. Regular air & water quality monitoring shall be carried out by PP before discharging it into the nearby agriculture fields from authorized laboratory in consultation with Regional Officer, MPPCB.







- XII. PP shall ensure generation of employment opportunities to nearby Village on priority bases.
- XIII. Payments of wages to the workers shall be done in consonance with the provisions in the labour laws.
- XIV. Proper infrastructure with shelter, drinking water, toilet and first-aid facilities shall be provided for the laborers. A provision should be made to construct a pakka rest shelter along with toilet and drinking water facility.
- XV. PP should also carry out regular sprinkling of water in the mining lease area to arrest dust emission from mining activities affecting the nearby agriculture fields
- XVI. Mining shall be limited to the area as shown in surface plan and as per the approved mining scheme.
- XVII. PP shall ensure to construct and maintain approach road from the mine site. Plantation will be carried out on both sides of the approach road. PP shall also ensure maintenance of existing pakka road in consultation with competent authority.
- XVIII. PP shall ensure proper water supply arrangements for plantation especially in summer season.
- XIX. PP shall ensure proper implementation of plantation, dust suppression, construction of approach road and maintenance of existing pakka road as part of Environmental Management Plan. Additional budget provision shall be made as part of EMP.
- XX. The ores and minerals shall be covered by tarpaulin or by such other means when transported out of the mine by road. The vehicles shall not be overloaded.
- XXI. PP should ensure to complete the activities listed under ecological remediation, Natural resource augmentation & community resource augmentation for a total amount of Rs. **9,55,000/-** within a period of six months and submit compliance in SEIAA.
- XXII. PP must ensure implementation of the following activities with separate budget provision of Rs. 5.0 Lakhs as recurring cost under CSR as committed.
  - a) Financial aid to village school for strengthening school campus.
  - b) Skill development/skill up gradation program for ladies to make them economically self reliant.
  - c) Solar lighting Installation on near villages roads
  - d) Skill Development (like Mobile repairing training, Advance Agriculture Practices, Animal Husbandry etc.
  - e) Distribution of Books/computers/Drawing sheets to children of schools.
  - f) Water sprinkling system installation in schools of nearby villages

All the modification to the above activities can be made with the permission of the district administration and need based activity for the development of nearby villages shall be implemented by PP in consultation with the District Collector and Grampanchayat.

- XXIII. PP should ensure to submit half yearly compliance report and CSR activity report with photographs of plantation in MP-SEIAA. If PP is failed to upload or submit two consecutive half yearly compliance reports of EC conditions to concerned authority (SEIAA and Regional Office, MoEF&CC, Gol, Bhopal) than prior environmental clearance issued to PP will automatically be treated as cancelled/ revoked as per OM No. 930/SEIAA/2019 dated 30.05.2019 issued by MPSEIAA.




- i. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
  - ii. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.
  - iii. PP shall leave 50 m from earthen bund towards western direction as no mining zone and raise thick plantation in this area.
  - iv. The depth of the pit shall be as per the Approved Mining Plan.
  - v. The entire area shall be fenced and three rows of plantation should be done on the periphery of the boundary.
  - vi. PP shall ensure the proper water supply arrangements for dust suppression, regular sprinkling, plantation and drinking purposes especially in summer season.
  - vii. Total 2850 saplings shall be planted by PP under plantation programme suitable indigenous tree species Lease boundary, approach road. Plantation of Neem, Amaltas, Pipal Imali etc. on priority shall be ensured by PP.
  - viii. PP shall ensure proper implementation of plantation, dust suppression, construction of approach road and maintenance of existing pakka road as part of Environmental Management Plan. Additional budget provision shall be made as part of EMP.
  - ix. PP must ensure implementation of the following activities with separate budget provision of Rs.1.95 Lakh/years under CER.
    - a) Development of infrastructure of School of nearby five villages namely Nitahara, Garhikhera (As per need requirement) –1. Develop laboratory of Science, Geography, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics etc in the School of Villages. 2. Develop library, playground, drinking water facilities in Schools. 3. Provide to sports equipment distribution.
    - b) Installation of a R.O. in Nitahara primary health center.
    - c) Provision will be made for rain water harvesting at a Nitahara School.
- The modification to the above activities can be made with the permission of the district administration and need based activity for the development of nearby villages shall be implemented by PP in consultation with the District Collector and Gram Panchayat.**
- x. PP should ensure to submit half yearly compliance report and CSR activity report with photographs of plantation in MP-SEIAA. If PP is failed to upload or submit two consecutive half yearly compliance reports of EC conditions to concerned authority (SEIAA and Regional Office, MoEF&CC, GoI, Bhopal) than prior environmental clearance issued to PP will automatically be treated as cancelled/ revoked as per OM No. 930/SEIAA/2019 dated 30.05.2019 issued by MPSEIAA.
