
This case was recommended in 413th SEAC meeting dated 10.12.2019, PP may be called for presentation.


23. **Case No 4475/2015 of DEIAA, Bhopal** – Prior Environmental Clearance of Stone Boulder Quarry in an area of 2.0 ha at khasra No. 564/2/1 for production capacity of 18,000 cum/year at Village- Barkheda nathu, Tehsil-Huzur, District-Bhopal by Smt. Sonia Sood W/o Shri Ish Kumar Sood, Owner, R/o E-2/42, Arera Colony, Bhopal (MP)-462016.

Smt. Rachna Chouksey, Project Proponent has submitted an application dated 11.11.2019 to review the environmental clearance granted in favour of PP by DEIAA for period upto 31.03.2019 vide its order No. 08/DEIAA/2016 dated 16.5.2016 while lease was granted upto 27.07.2019. It is to mention here that Collector Office has renewed mining lease from 28.7.19 to 27.07.29. As per procedure, environmental clearance is normally granted for mining lease period and as per MoEF&CC, Gol Office Memorandum No. J-11011/15/2012-IA.-II(M) dated 20.3.2015, the Project Proponent which has valid and subsisting EC for their mining project either under EIA Notification 1994 or 2006 will not be required to obtain fresh EC at the time of renewal of lease.

After detailed discussion and deliberation, it is decided to call complete documents/technical file with recommendation of DEAC from DEIAA, Bhopal

Smt. Rachna Chouksey, Project Proponent has submitted an application dated 13.11.2019 to review the environmental clearance granted in favour of PP by DEIAA for period upto 31.03.2019 vide its order No. 64/DEIAA/2016 dated 23.5.2016 while Collector Office has renewed mining lease for 10 years upto 23.12.25 vide letter dated 2619/khanij/उ.प./ 2015 dated 13.10.15. As per procedure, environmental clearance is normally granted for mining lease period and as per MoEF&CC, Gol Office Memorandum No. J-11011/15/2012-IA.-II(M) dated 20.3.2015, the Project Proponent which has valid and subsisting EC for their mining project either under EIA Notification 1994 or 2006 will not be required to obtain fresh EC at the time of renewal of lease.


Hon'ble NGT (PB) vide order dated 26.07.2019 has given following direction in OA No. 726/2018 – Mr. Rupesh Pethe Vs State of M.P. & others:


"The mining lease has to be granted only after Environment Management Plan is reviewed by the SEIAA following the sustainable Sand Mining Guidelines-2016 of MoEF&CC of the year 2016.


The State of M.P. may ensure compliance of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Deepak Kumar (Supra) and of this Tribunal in Satendra Pandey (Supra) and permit mining only after Environment Management Plan is approved by the SEIAA."

In compliance of the above order dated 26.07.19 passed by Hon'ble NGT in the matter of OA No. 726/2018, PP has submitted Environment Management Plan in SEIAA vide letter dated 12.12.19 for necessary action. After discussion, it was decided to send the EMP submitted by PP to SEAC for review and critical examination for considering necessary approval as per direction of Hon'ble NGT.
