After detailed discussions and perusal of recommendations of 415<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dated 07.01.2020, presentation made by the PP in SEIAA, it was decided to accept the recommendation of SEAC for grant of prior EC to the project subject to the following specific conditions:-

- I. Before commencing any mining activity fencing shall be carried out all around the lease area. Proper watch and ward arrangements should be made with installation of signage at 4 corners of lease area to avoid any untoward incident involving public and animals by the PP.
- II. PP shall not start mining activity before execution of lease agreement.

- VIII. PP shall ensure proper implementation of plantation, dust suppression, construction of approach road and maintenance of existing pakka road & as part of Environmental Management Plan. Additional budget provision shall be made as part of EMP.
- IX. Total 3000 saplings shall be planted in 3 years by PP in first three years under plantation programme. Suitable tree species i.e. Bargad, sissoo, pipal, neem, amla, mango etc. at approach road, village area, mine lease boundary & barrier zone shall be ensured by PP on priority.
- X. PP must ensure implementation of the following activities with separate budget provision of Rs 0.45 lakh / year under CER
  - (a) 1st year: Sumeda village (>370 household) -
    - Roof top rainwater harvesting in panchayat bhawan, school building & PHC (Rs. 1,20,000/-).
    - Traffic awareness program (safety campaign on road) with briefing on PUC vehicles in combating the pollution in consultation with Gram Panchayat and local authority (Rs. 15,000/-)
  - (b) 2<sup>nd</sup> year: Sumeda village (>370 household) -
    - Distribution of sports kit at village school (Rs.15,000/-).
    - Awareness Programm for plastic free village (twice a year), distribution of cloth bags (Rs. 1,20,000/-).
  - (c) 3<sup>rd</sup> year: Degarhat village (>170 household) -
    - Traffic awareness program (safety campaign on road) with briefing on PUC vehicles in combating the pollution in consultation with Gram Panchayat and local authority (Rs. 15,000/-).

Awareness Programm for plastic free village (twice a year), distribution of cloth bags (Rs. 1,20,000/-)

If PP is failed to upload or submit two consecutive half yearly compliance reports of EC conditions to concerned authority (SEIAA and Regional Office, MoEF&CC,Gol,Bhopal) than prior environmental clearance issued to PP will automatically be treated as cancelled/ revoked as per OM No. 930/SEIAA/2019 dated 30.05.2019 issued by MPSEIAA.

"The mining lease has to be granted only after Environmental Management Plan is reviewed by the SEIAA following the sustainable Sand Mining Guidelines -2016 of MoEF & CC of the year 2016.

The state of M.P. may ensure compliance of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Deepak Kumar (Supra) and of his Tribunal in Satendra Pandey (Supra) and permit mining only after Environmental Management Plan is approved by the SEIAA".

In compliance of the above order dated 26.07.19 passed by Hon'ble NGT in the matter of OA No. 726/2018, PP has submitted Environmental Management Plan in SEIAA vide letter dated 06.12.19 for necessary action. After discussion, it was decided to send the EMP submitted by PP to SEAC for review and critical examination for considering necessary approval as per direction of Hon'ble NGT.

The EMP was presented by PP and their consultant. PP submitted they have submitted to copy of earlier EC, CTO obtained from MPPCB, Verified volume of sand evacuated from the lease by concerned authority, lease transfer order from earlier PP to Gram Panchayat copy of six monthly compliance reports with photographs submitted to concerned authority and EMP with replenishment plan. PP further submitted that they have also submitted their desired declaration and RQP affidavit as the proposed EMP in prepared by RQP.

Committee after presentation asked PP to revise the plantation species, their number accordingly to lease area (@ 1000/ ha.) in scheme of plantation and commensurate
