No River Sand Mining is allowed in rainy season (monsoon) as per Sustainable Sand Mining Management Guidelines-2016 of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India. The period of Rainy Season viz. Normal dates of onset and withdrawal of Southwest Monsoon in Madhya Pradesh based on Indian Meteorological data is from 15<sup>th</sup> June to 1<sup>st</sup> October. However, District Collector of concerned district can make necessary changes as per local meteorological variations in this period of rainy season with respect to prohibition of River Sand Mining in the district.
