Office Memorandum

1. In reference to EIA notification, 2006 the Madhya Pradesh State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) considers the cases for grant of Prior Environmental Clearance of the cases as per schedule based on recommendations of the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC).
2. It is observed that unnecessary delay is occurring due to non availability of documents before SEIAA, listed in **Annexure-I** when the case recommended by SEAC is put up for consideration.
3. Therefore, in order to expedite the decision by SEAC/SEIAA, the PP should submit the notarized / certified copies of the required necessary documents listed in **Annexure-I** along with an application duly signed addressed to the member secretary, State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority in format given in **Annexure-II** at the time of submission of the EIA report.
4. Documents as desired in paragraph-3 above may be submitted along with an application duly signed and addressed to the member secretary State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority in format given in **Annexure-II** at the earliest by the project proponent, in the cases in which EIA report has already been submitted.

Annex-I

Documents required by SEIAA / SEAC for consideration of the cases related to prior Environmental Clearance

- i. **Interstate Boundary Distance:** A letter from Collector/ Executive Engineer PWD of the concerned district indicating distance of the project site from Interstate Boundary (In 32 districts as given in **Annex-iii**). This document is not required in case of items of 8 (a) & 8 (b)
- ii. **Distance from the Protected Areas (PAs):** A letter from Chief Wildlife Warden indicating distance of the project site from the Protected Areas (PAs) viz., National Park, Sanctuary, Tiger Reserve as per Wildlife Protection Act 1972. This document is not required in case of items of 8 (a) & 8 (b).
- iii. **Distance from the Critically Polluted Area:** A letter from Collector/Municipal Corporation of the concerned district indicating distance of the project site from the Critically Polluted Area for the projects related to s.no. 1 to 7 of the schedule of EIA notification 2006. This document is required only in two districts namely Indore and Singrauli (as given in annex-iv).
- iv. **Mining Cases:**
 - a. A letter from concerned DFO indicating distance of the mining area from the nearest forest. If the distance is less than 250 m, then NOC from the committee constituted under the Chairmanship of Jila Panchayat for the mining lease sanctioned from 07-10-02 to 29-08-08 and from committee constituted under Chairmanship of PS, Forests from 29-08-08 onwards.
 - b. A notarized copy of the mining lease deed and sanction/ allotment order from the State Govt.
- v. **Land Ownership documents to be used by the project:**
 - a. Latest Khasra Panchshala (P-II) for revenue land (Government or Private)
 - b. If project site include land of any industrial area then notarized copy the map of the industrial area indicating location of the unit including copy of the allotment / agreement letter from the competent authority.
 - c. If the project site includes forest land, then notarized copy of the forest clearance as per Forest Conservation Act, 1980 or a notarized copy of the application made to Ministry of Forest and Environment mentioning stage - I of the forest clearance.
- vi. **Water Requirement:**
 - a. Commitment letter for water supply from the Gram Panchayat/ Municipal Bodies/ Water Resource Department / AKVN etc., if any.
 - b. NOC from Central Ground Water Board as applicable for meeting water requirement from groundwater.
- vii. **Building/Construction Projects:**
 - a. **Building Construction /Township Projects:** Approval of the layout plan by T&CP,



- b. **Building Construction /Township Projects:**Approval from Nagar Nigam/ Nagar Palika/ Nagar Panchayat/ Gram Panchayat as applicable.
- c. **Highrise Building Projects:** Approval letter from the T & CP after due approval of the committee constituted by State Govt. as applicable.
- viii. **NOC from Gram Sabha:** If the project is lying within schedule notified area (83 blocks), then resolution of the Gram Sabha.
- ix. **Diversion of Order from SDO (Revenue) :** Diversion plan duly approved by competent authority for industrial and infrastructure projects, if located outside industrial area. A landuse certificate from T&Cp if land is lying in planning area as notified by T& CP.
- x. **Ownership of EIA Report and Other Documents by PP:** A certificate by Project Proponent owning the content of EIA report and other documents.
- xi. **Accreditation Certificate of EIA Consultants:** A certificate by the consultant for accreditation by MOEF, Gol
- xii. **Summary of the EIA**


