

Minutes of the 11th SEIAA Meeting held on 13th March, 2009

The 11th meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 13th March, 2009 at 11.30 A M at the Authority's office in M.P. Pollution Control Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal chaired by Shri Subroto Banerji.

(I) Case recommended by SEAC after reconsideration

1. M/s BLA Pvt Ltd, 84, Maker Chamber III, Nariman point, Mumbai, 140 MW Thermal Power Plant at Vill- Niwari Teh-Gadarwara, Distt-Narsinghpur-M.P. **Case no 178/2008.**

The above case has been recommended by SEAC after reconsideration. As regards the issue of non-possession of the complete land, the SEIAA accepts the clarification submitted by the project proponent that the 78.87 acres of land which is already in possession of the project proponent is sufficient to accommodate 1x70 M W unit. Hence SEIAA decided to grant environmental clearance to one unit of 70 MW. Separate clearance will be required for the other unit of 70 MW after getting the possession of remaining land.

(II) Case deferred by SEIAA

1. M/s Bright star Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd, Indore- M.P, Residential Township project at Jatkhedi, Hoshangabad Road, Bhopal-M.P. (Group Housing & Commercial Area Deve.) **Case No. 43/2008.**

The above case was deferred in the last SEIAA meeting for verification of issues related to land ownership. After detailed scrutiny of the documents submitted by the project proponent it appears that the whole land has not yet been transferred in the name of project proponent. Hence SEIAA decided to send the proposal back to SEAC for reconsideration on the issue of verification of revenue record in the name of the project proponent.

(III) Cases recommended by SEAC for granting prior environment clearance

1. M/s Birla Corporation Ltd, Cement Division, P.O Birla Vikas, Satna M.P., Coal Washery plant of capacity 0.96 MTPA, Raghuraj Nagar, Satna M.P. **Case No.238/2008.**

It is a coal washery plant proposed within the premises of the existing cement plant. SEAC recommended the proposal for granting environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord environmental clearance.

2. M/s Gajraj Singh, Gandhigram, Sehora, Jabalpur, Laterite, iron ore, manganese ore and yellow ochre mine in 5.80 ha at village Gandhigram Teh. Sihora , Distt.Jabalpur-M.P. **Case No. 37/2008.**

SEAC recommended the above proposal for grant of environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord environmental clearance.

3. M/s Nectar Mining Company, 188-Rizwan Bagh, Lalghati, Bhopal, Kurro-Mansahara Laterite Deposit Mines, 17.07 ha. at Village Kurro and Mansakra, Teh-Sihora, Distt-Jabalpur-M.P. Case No. 86 /2008.

SEAC recommended the above proposal for grant of environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord environmental clearance.

4. M/s Agrawal Mineral Process, Chhindwara M.P. Mines 5 Ha., Village-Gwari-wodona, Teh-Sausar, Distt-Chhindwara. **Case No. 06/2008.**

SEAC recommended the above proposal for grant of environmental clearance. SEIAA during scrutiny of the documents submitted by the project proponent found that some settlements are located on the mining lease area. Hence it was decided to send the case back to SEAC for reconsideration. SEAC is advised to ask the project proponent to rehabilitate project affected persons as well as take concrete measures to obviate dust and sound pollution. The case may be put up before SEIAA after the above mentioned requirements have been incorporated.

5. Shakambhari Mines and Minerals, Kamtee-Distt, Nagpur M.P., Mines 6.607 Ha.Gowari-Wodona, Sonsar, Chhindwara-M.P. **Case No. 08/2008.**

SEAC recommended the above proposal for grant of environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord environmental clearance.

6. M/s Mohta Cement Pvt Ltd, Indore- M.P. Expansion of our existing Mini Cement Unit at 61/62, Sector-3, Pithampur, Distt – Dhar from 30 TPD to 300 TPD, **Case No. 91/2008**

The above projects pertains to the expansion of a existing cement plant. SEAC after appraisal has recommended the proposal for granting environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord environmental clearance to the above project.

7. M/s S.R. Ferro Alloys, Aditya Avenue, M.P. Nagar, Zone II, Bhopal, Kajali Dongari, Manganese mine 30.86 ha. at Village Kajali, Dongari, Talluka-Jhabua-M.P.Distt- Jhabua-M.P. **Case No. 112/2008.**

The above case has been recommended by SEAC for grant of environmental clearance. SEIAA decided to defer the decision on this project till next meeting as the case needs detailed scrutiny of the report on the objections received on the project and subsequently forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC.

8. Krishna Metal Agency, 158/B, Sector 'F' Narwal Chouraha, Sanwer Road, Indore M.P, Small scale lead processing of 1000 MT/year at plot No. 158/ B sector, F- Industrial Area, Sanwer Road, Indore-M.P. **Case No. 120/2008.**

SEAC recommended the above proposal for grant of environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord environmental clearance.
