

Minutes of the 12th SEIAA Meeting held on 17th April, 2009

The 12th meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 17th April, 2009 at 11.30 A M at the Authority's office in M.P. Pollution Control Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal chaired by Shri Subroto Banerji.

(I) Case recommended by SEAC for Environmental Clearance.

1. Ramnik Power and Alloys Pvt Ltd, C/o M/s A.P Trivedi sons, Main Road., Balaghat Biomass based power plant for captive use at Vill-sarandi, Teh-Wara Seoni, Distt- Balaghat M.P. Case No **109/2008**.

The above case was sent to SEAC for reconsideration on the ground of non-submission of NOC from Central Ground Water Board to draw ground water for the proposed 6 MW bio-mass based power plant.

Project Proponent has submitted the NOC from Central Ground Water Board to draw ground water. SEAC has recommended the case for granting environmental clearance.

SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord the environmental clearance.

2. Rajmata Vijayaraje Sindhiya, AIIMS, Bhopal .**case no 110/2008**

The above case was sent back to SEAC for reconsideration, since the project proponent did not submit the building permission from Municipal Corporation, Bhopal. SEAC recommended the case for grant of environmental clearance advising project proponent to submit building permission directly to SEIAA.

SEIAA accepted the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant environmental clearance to the above project. It was decided that it will be issued after submission of the building permission by the project proponent to the SEIAA.

3. PGH International Pvt Ltd., Shopping Mall cum multiplex Raslakhedi, Karond –Bhanpur bye-pass road. Bhopal-M.P. **case no.12/2008**

The above case was sent back to SEAC for reconsideration on the ground of non submission of NOC from Central Ground Water Board. The same has been obtained by the project proponent and was submitted to SEAC. SEAC recommended the case for grant of Environmental Clearance.

Central Ground Water Board has granted permission to draw water except during period of construction and only till the project proponent gets Narmada water supply. The planning permission issued by Jt. Director T & CP contains a condition that project proponent has to make his own arrangements for water supply, whereas the building permission issued by Municipal Corporation does not contain any commitment to supply water to the project proponent.

Hence SEIAA decided to send back the proposal to reexamine on the point of supply of water by the Bhopal Municipal Corporation to the project proponent during construction and operation phase.

4. Jam Manganese ore mines of M/s Chimanlal Rawal 9.09 hact. At Vill Jam, Teh- Katangi, Distt- Balaghat M.P. **case no 240/2008**

The above case has been recommended by SEAC for grant of Environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord Environmental Clearance to the above project.

(II) Case deferred by SEIAA

1. M/s S.R. Ferro Alloys, Aditya Avenue, M.P. Nagar, Zone II, Bhopal, Kajali Dongari Manganese mine 30.86 ha. at Village Kajali, Dongari, Talluka-Jhabua, Distt- Jhabua- M.P. **case no 112/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of Environmental Clearance. SEIAA decided to defer it in its 11th meeting. After detailed scrutiny of the project documents, public hearing report and the objections raised by people, SEIAA found that there seems to be possible threat to human health (possibility of silicosis) and contamination of ground water. Since it is a previously existing mine hence Pollution Control Board must be having data related to air, water and health condition of the people residing in the surrounding areas. It was decided to send the above case back to SEAC for reconsideration and clear recommendation on the above issues.
