

Minutes of the 14th SEIAA Meeting held on 25th May, 2009

The 14th meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 25th May, 2009 at 11.30 A M at the Authority's office in M.P. Pollution Control Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal chaired by Shri Subroto Banerji.

(I) Case recommended by SEAC for Environmental Clearance.

1. M/s Agrawal Mineral Process, Manganese ore mine 5 ha., Village-Gwari-wodona, Teh-Sausar, Distt-Chhindwara, **Case No. 6/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of environmental clearance. SEIAA after scrutinizing the documents found that there are seven hutments which are to be rehabilitated. As per records, the project proponent has paid Rs.50,000/- to each one of them. SEIAA decided to send the above case back to SEAC to opine clearly whether the compensation amount and procedure is as per the government norms.

2. M/s Anupam Marbles, Pvt. Ltd, Mining of marble blocks, village-Kaaripathar, Teh-Dhimerkheda, Katni-M.P. **Case No.26/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord environmental clearance to the project.

3. M/s Balasore Alloys Ltd, Mining of Manganese ore 17-017 Ha., Village-Hathoda Teh- Katangi, Distt. Balaghat M.P. **Case No.10/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for granting environmental clearance. While examining the documents submitted by the project proponent, it came to notice of the committee that some of the khasras of the mining area are located within 250 m from the forest boundary. Although a no objection to these Khasras have been issued by a committee headed by the Collector, it was decided to clarify who was the Competent Authority to give permission on behalf of the Forest Department. Hence SEIAA decided to defer the decision in this case till next meeting.

4. M/s Smt. Shakuntla Kasal, Mining of Manganese ore 6.99 ha.. Village- Hatoda Teh- Katangi, Distt- Balaghat-M.P. **Case No.83/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for granting environmental clearance. While examining the documents submitted by the project proponent,. it came to notice of the committee that some of the khasras of the mining area are located within 250 m from the forest boundary. Although a no objection to these Khasras have been issued by a committee headed by the Collector, it was decided to clarify who was the Competent Authority to give permission in behalf of the Forest Department. Hence SEIAA decided to defer the decision in this case till next meeting.

5. M/s Yogesh Kumar Paliwal Mining of Marble 7.09 ha, Village Jujhawal Tehsil- Bahoriband, Distt. Katni (M.P) -- **Case No.49/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for granting environmental clearance. SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord environmental clearance to the project.

6. H K Kalchuri Education Trust, 31, Shamla Hills, Bhopal M.P., 10.61 hact. Construction of Hospital complex at Kolar Road, Bhopal-M.P. **Case No.217/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for granting environmental clearance.

While scrutinizing the documents submitted by the project proponent, it was noticed that

- Building permission from Kolar Nagar Palika has not been submitted by project proponent.
- Land record showing the land ownership in the name of the project proponent has not been submitted.
- Despite of the condition of CGWB prohibiting use of ground water for construction, project proponent has mentioned in the document that it will be used for construction.

Hence SEIAA decided to send the case back to SEAC for reconsideration on the above grounds.

7. 21st century (P) Ltd, Bhopal, Construction of shopping mall with multiplex at village- Misrod, Teh- Huzur Distt- Bhopal-M.P. **Case No.55/2008**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of environmental clearance. While scrutinizing the documents submitted by the project proponent, it was noticed that CGWB has issued a no objection certificate to draw ground water on the condition that it will not be used for construction, while the project proponent has mentioned that ground water will be used for construction phase. Hence it was decided to send this case back to SEAC for reconsideration on the above ground.
