

Minutes of the 19th SEIAA Meeting held on 2nd September, 2009

The 19th meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 2nd September, 2009 at 11.30 A M at the Authority's office in M.P. Pollution Control Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal chaired by Shri Subroto Banerji.

(I) Cases recommended by SEAC for Environmental Clearance after reconsideration

1. 21st century (P) Ltd, Bhopal, Construction of shopping mall with multiplex at village- Misrod, Teh- Huzur Distt- Bhopal-M.P. **Case no.55/2008.**

The above case was sent back to SEAC to get clarification on the source of water to be used during the construction phase, since CGWB has prohibited use of ground water for this purpose.

The project proponent has given a commitment to use treated waste water provided by M/s Bhaskar Industries Pvt. Ltd, Mandeideep. SEAC accepted the commitment of the project proponent and recommended it for environmental clearance.

SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to grant environmental clearance to the above project.

2. M/s J P Agrawal, H I G Housing Board Colony, P O Katni, Marble mine 10.520 ha. at village – Khadra, Teh-Bahoriband, Distt- Katni-M.P. **Case no.247/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of environmental clearance.

SEIAA accepted the recommendation of SEAC and decided to accord prior environmental clearance to the project.

3. M/s M.P Lime works Jabalpur, Dolomite mine area 10.60 ha. Vill-Seoni, Teh.& Distt. Jabalpur, M.P. **Case no. 27/2008**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of environmental clearance.

While scrutinizing the documents Authority found that the project proponent has not submitted the NOC issued by the Forest Deptt.

Hence it was decided to send the above case back to SEAC for reconsideration on the above ground.

4. M/s N M Dubash stone and lime Co, Pvt Ltd, Lime stone and Dolomite mine 17.07 ha. at village Bistara Tehsil- Vijay Raghogarh Distt. Katni. M.P. **Case no. 23/2008**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of environmental clearance. While scrutinizing the documents submitted by the project proponent it was noticed that the mining lease area is located between 105 to 245 mts from forest boundary. As per the Govt.of M.P. Forest Deptts order no F/5/16/81/10-3 dt 27/8/08, mines located within a distance of 250 mts from the forest boundary requires clearance from a committee headed by the Principal Secretary, Govt. of M.P., Forest Deptt.

Since the project proponent has not submitted a NOC issued by the above committee, SEIAA decided to reject the case on the above ground.

5. Shri S. M. Bedia, Dolomite mine 9.70 ha. 4000 TPA Vill-Kund, Teh-Alirajpur, Distt-Jhabua M.P. **Case no. 137/2008**

SEAC recommended the above case for grant of environmental clearance. SEIAA while scrutinizing the public hearing report submitted by the District Collector and other members, observed that it is neither focused nor to the point. The Collector has not expressed a clear opinion in the report either.

Hence it was decided that a clear opinion in this regard may be sought from the District Collector before taking final decision in the above project.

6. M/s Laxminarayan mining Co. Dolomite mine 8.093 ha. 4000 TPA at Vill-Panwani, Teh- Alirajpur, Distt-Jhabua-M.P. **Case no. 136/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of environmental clearance. While scrutinizing the documents submitted by the project proponent it was noticed that the Forest Deptt. NOC does not mention the distance of the mining lease area from the forest boundary. Hence it was decided to send the case back to SEAC for reconsideration and verification on the above ground.
