(A) Cases recommended for Environmental Clearance by SEAC

1. M/s Jakhodia Minerals, 184, Samta Colony, Raipur , C.G., Laterite, Hematite and blue dust mine 6-880 ha. Village Dhamki, Teh-Sihora, Distt- Jabalpur- M.P. **Case No.76/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of Environmental Clearance.

SEIAA accepted the recommendations of SEAC and decided to accord Prior Environmental Clearance to the above project.

2. M/s Ramawtar Agrawal, Prabhat Vihar colony, Panna naka-Satna M.P., Chachandeeh Bauxite mine, 17.744 ha. at Village Chachandeeh, Talluka - Pushprajgarh- Anuppur M.P. **Case No.100/2008.**

The above case was recommended by SEAC for grant of prior environmental clearance. It is an existing mine having a production capacity of 50000 T/year. The prior environmental clearance to the above mine was issued by Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India vide letter no. J-11015/442/2005-IA II (M) dt 26-07-2006.

The project proponent has applied to the Authority for prior environmental clearance for doubling the production capacity i.e. 100000T/year from the existing capacity of 50000 T/year.

The Authority decided to get opinion of the Distt. Collector on how the mine has functioned during the last three years i.e. after issue of Prior Environmental Clearance from MoEF in the year 2006, as well as the compliance status of various conditions laid down by MoEF in their Environmental clearance letter. Till such time the case is deferred.

3. M/s Ganesh Vishwakarma, Jalpadevi Ward, Gautam Maholla, Katni M.P., Bauxite, Laterite, fireclay and yellow ochre mines, 27-35 ha. Village –Tikariya, Teh-Murwara, Distt.Katni-M.P. **Case No.60/2008**
4. M/s Puralal Vishwakarma, Katni M.P, Bauxite, Laterite, fire clay mine in 12.97 ha. at Village Tharka, Katni -M.P. **Case No.39/2008**
5. M/s Savitri Minerals Pathak ward, Katni M.P., Laterite and Bauxite mine 8.094 ha. at Village Tikaria, **Case No.54/2008**

All the above three cases have been recommended by SEAC for Prior Environmental Clearance.

The Authority while scrutinizing the Public Hearing Report realized that the number of persons present during the hearing are not representative of the community.

Secondly all the three reports seems to be proto types.

Hence it was decided to write to the Distt. Collector, Katni to verify the facts mentioned in the public hearing report.
