

Minutes of the 55th Meeting of SEIAA (28-03-2011)

The 55th meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority was convened on 28th March, 2011 at 10.30 A. M. at the Authority's office in M.P. Pollution Control Board Building, Paryavaran Parisar, Bhopal chaired by Shri Amar Singh, Chairman SEIAA.

Cases to be reconsidered by SEIAA, which fall in the new critically polluted area and at a prescribed distance from its boundary according to the provisions of Office Memorandum MoEF, Gol dated 13-01-2010 and its clarification dated 15-03-2010 by the MoEF, Gol.

1. **Case no 500/2010, Bharat Petroleum Corpn. Ltd, LPG filling plant plot no 6 & 7, Kheda Industrial area sector, Pitampur, Distt- Dhar, Additional LPG mounded storage (1X600) MT at existing LPG plant at plot no 6 & 7 Kheda industrial area sector-4, Pithampur, Dhar-M.P.**

The decision to grant Prior Environmental Clearance was taken in 45th SEIAA meeting held on 10-01-11. It is felt by the Authority that in 45th SEIAA meeting the case could not be examined in light of MoEF, Gol office memorandum dt 13-01-2010, hence it is being reconsidered. The decision to grant Environmental Clearance is being kept in abeyance, because distance of the project area from Indore Municipal Corporation limits and Rau Industrial area limits is not readily available. Hence, it was decided by the Authority to write to M.D., ADKVN, Indore to intimate such distances by 30th April 2011. After the receipt of Information from M D, AKVN Indore, the case will be re-examined in SEIAA meeting.

2. **505/2010, M/s Pluton Cement Pvt. Ltd, S/o Jankinagar extension, Distt-Indore-M.P. Expansion of cement production capacity from 6600 TPA to 19800 TPA at 52-54 A, Sector-3, Pithampur, Distt-Dhar-M.P.** Expansion of cement production capacity from 6600 TPA to 19800 TPA at 52-54 A, Sector-3, Pithampur, Distt-Dhar-M.P.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents submitted by the Proponent observed that it has not submitted application in prescribed Form-I as per amendment of MoEF, Gol Notification dt 1-12-2009. Hence, it was decided by the Authority to return all the documents to the Project Proponent except application letter and ToR issued by SEAC, to submit application in new prescribed Form I. Secondly, it was decided to write to Collector, Dhar to ascertain distance from Indore Municipal Corporation limits and Rau industrial area limits of this factory by 31st May 2011.

3. **543/2010, Mr. Umesh Linani, Director, 55-Shanti Niketan, near Bombay Hospital, Distt-Indore-M.P.**, High rise residential group housing at village Nipania, Teh.& Distt-Indore-M.P.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents observed that as per information provided by the Proponent in the presentation made before SEAC on 25-05-10 the project site is 9 Km away from Indore Railway Station, which is critically polluted. The notification of MoEF, GOI dated 14th September 2006 mentions General Condition and according to it any project or activity specified in Category `B` will be treated as Category `A` if located in whole or in part within 10 km from the boundary of - (ii) critically polluted areas as notified by CPCB from time to time. Hence, the project would be treated as Category `A` and a decision for Prior Environmental Clearance could be taken by MoEF, GOI. The Authority decided to return the case along with all the documents to Project Proponent.

4. **546/2010, M/s Lupin Pharmacare Ltd, Plot No. 2, SEZ, Pithampur, Phase-II, Apparel park, Distt-Dhar-M.P.**, Manufacturing facility for formulation products and active pharmaceutical ingredients (API) at plot no-2, SEZ, Phase-II, Pithampur, Distt-Dhar-M.P.

The Authority examined the case. In view of MoEF-GOI office memorandum dt 13-01-2010, it was decided to write to M D, AKVN, Indore to ascertain distance from Rau industrial area and Indore Municipal Corporation limits of this factory by 30th April, 2011.

5. **600/2010M/s Mittal Corporation Ltd, Abhay Prasad (West wing), 10, Race course road, Distt-Indore-M.P.**, SS wire road of capacity 360000 MTPA at plot no 164 C Sec-3, Industrial area, Distt-Pithampur-M.P.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents submitted by the Proponent observed that he has not submitted application in prescribed Form-I as per amendment of MoEF, GOI Notification dt 1-12-2009. Hence, it was decided by the Authority to return all the documents to the Project Proponent except application letter and ToR issued by SEAC, to submit project information in new prescribed form. Secondly, it was decided to write to Collector, Dhar to ascertain distance from Indore Municipal Corporation limits and Rau industrial area limits of this unit by 31st May 2011.

6. **607/2010, M/s IVRCL Industries & projects Ltd Village- Gyanpura, Jhabua Road, Dhar-M.P.**, Basalt stone mine 37.5 Ha. at village Rangwasa, Teh- Depalpur, Distt-Indore -M.P.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents submitted by the Proponent observed that he has not submitted application in prescribed Form-I as per amendment of MoEF, GOI Notification dt 1-12-2009. Hence, it was decided by the Authority to return all the documents to the Project Proponent to submit project information in new prescribed form. Secondly, it was decided to write to Collector, Indore to ascertain distance of mine area at village Rangwasa, Teh- Depalpur, from Indore Municipal Corporation limits by 31st May 2011.

7. **614/2010, M/s J K M Projects Pvt Ltd, C/o J K Investment Pvt Ltd, MR- 10, Near Toll Tax Booth, Hotel-Sheraton, Distt-Indore-M.P.**, Prem Shanti “Residency Construction Project” at village Kumerdi-Teh-Sanwer Distt-Indore-M.P.

The Authority while scrutinizing the documents observed that as per information provided by the Proponent the project site is 8 Km away from Indore Railway Station and Indore city is critically polluted. The notification of MoEF, GOI dated 14th September 2006 mentions General Condition that any project or activity specified in Category `B` will be treated as Category `A` if located in whole or in part within 10 km from the boundary of - (ii) critically polluted areas as notified by CPCB from time to time. Hence, the project would be treated as Category `A` and a decision for Prior Environmental Clearance could be taken by MoEF, GOI. The Authority decided to return the case along with all the documents to Project Proponent.

8. **511/2010, Trimula Industries Ltd, H- No. 45, Ward no-5, Main road, Singrauli , 38.5 M.M. captive power plant (AFBC- 1 x 20 MW & WHRB- 1x18.5 M and expansion (under construction- 1x350 TPD Trimula Industries Ltd at village Godwali & Bastali Biran, The- Devassar & Chitrang, Distt- Singrauli-M.P.**

In light of office memorandum 13-01-2010 issued by MoEF, Gol and its clarification dt 15-03-10 the Authority decided to write to Collector, Singrauli to send map of the district showing areas as indicated in office memorandum dt 15-03-10 issued by MoEF, Gol and also indicate distances of the proposed project at village Godwali and Bastali Biran, from Singrauli Municipal Corporation limit and from each such cluster separately.

B- Decision regarding cases to be discussed in next SEIAA meeting

9. The Authority felt that as per clause 4-4.1.1 of office memorandum dt 13-01-2010 issued by MoEF, Gol all cases of critically polluted area when Environmental Clearance has not been granted till 13-01-10 should be placed in the next meeting for reconsideration. Such cases can be of two categories. In the first category no Environmental Clearance has been granted till yet and in the second category can be where ECs might have been granted after 13-01-10 till November, 2010. Decisions in such cases from December, 2010 and till beginning of March 2011 have already been reconsidered in previous meetings. Hence the Nodal Officer, under supervision of Member Secretary, SEIAA will get all such cases sorted out and placed in next meeting.
