



1. **Case No. 2317/2014** Prior Environmental Clearance proposed Project "Raj Shahi Apartments, Raj Classic Apartments and Raj House" at Khasra no. 311/43, 43, 41, 45/1/1/1, 45/1/1/2/1 & 35/1, Village Narela Shankari, Tehsil Huzur, District Bhopal (MP); Total Plot Area 38823.19 sqm (3.88 ha); Total Built up Area 87653.22 sqm by M/s Raj Homes Pvt. Ltd., and Vishanupuri GNSS through Mr. Sanjay Mehta, Director, 21, Zone-II, M.P. Nagar, Bhopal-462011 (MP)

- (1) The proposed project is building & construction residential Project at Khasra no. 311/43, 43, 41, 45/1/1/1, 45/1/1/2/1 & 35/1, Village Narela Shankari, Tehsil Huzur, District Bhopal (MP). The project includes apartment, informal sector, Multi unit block and business centre.
- (2) As per the T & CP Bhopal (vide letter 1204 dtd.16/9/2014). The total land area is 38823.19 sqm (3.88 ha). The total built up area proposed by PP is 87653.22 sqm. The project comes under 8 (a) category (B) of schedule of EIA Notification, 2006 because total construction is between 20,000 sqm. & 1, 50,000 sqm and plot area is less than 50 ha.
- (3) The case was discussed in SEAC meetings 172nd dtd. 22.02.15 and is recommended for grant of prior EC subject to 04 special conditions.

2. **Case No. 2320/2014** Prior Environmental Clearance proposed Project "Global Institute of Medical Science & Health Care" at Khasra No. 141, 142/9, 142/10, 147/1, 181, 182/1, 182/2, 183/1, 183/2, 183/3, 212 & 244; Village Raigwan, Tehsil & District Jabalpur (MP); Total Plot Area 8.54 ha.; Total Built up Area 88362.74 sqm. by Global Institute Of Medical Sciences and Health Care through Partner Shri Saurabh Baderia, Baderia Pharma, 440, Wright Town, Jabalpur - 482002 email :saurabh@global.org.in Ph No. 0761- 440607

(1) The proposed project is building & construction of Medical College & Hospital premises at Khasra No. 141, 142/9, 142/10, 147/1, 181, 182/1, 182/2, 183/1, 183/2, 183/3, 212 & 244 Village Raigwan, Tehsil & District Jabalpur (MP) The project includes Teaching Hospital (750 Bedded) and Medical College (150 student per year).

(2) As per the T & CP Jabalpur (vide letter let no. 3287 dtd. 22.10.14.) the total land area is 8.54 ha. The total built up area proposed by PP is 88362.74 sqm. The project comes under 8 (a) category (B) of schedule of EIA Notification, 2006 because total construction is between 20,000 sqm & 1,50,000 sqm and plot area is less than 50 ha.

(3) The case was discussed in SEAC meeting 172nd dtd. 22.02.15 and is recommended for grant of prior EC subject to 05 special conditions.


(4) The case was discussed in depth and it is noted that :-


(i). As per Khasra Panchsala (2014-2015) the land is the name of Global Institute of Medical Science & Health Care through Director Shri Saurabh Baderia, Smt. Sonia Baderia, Smt. Manisha Nandwani, Shri Rajesh Nandwani, Shri Santosh Shukla, & Smt. Sushila Bai. PP has submitted notarized copy of lease deed between Global Institute of Medical Science & Health Care through Director Shri Saurabh Baderia and land owners.


(ii). The source of water supply is Municipal Corporation, Jabalpur (letter dtd 11.12.14). The total water requirement is 639 KLD. The fresh water requirement is 421 KLD & recycled water is 518 KLD. **It is decided that PP should ensure that the entire fresh water (421 KLD) demand is met through municipal supply and there is no extraction of ground water.**

(iii). The total waste water generation is 575 KLD. PP has provided sewage treatment plant of 600 KLD. The total treated waste water is 518 KLD. PP has proposed 100% recycling of treated waste water (218 KLD in flushing + 250 KLD for HVAC + 50 KLD horticulture). PP has submitted letter from Jabalpur Municipal Corporation dtd 12.12.14 regarding disposal of extra treated waste water in Municipal sewer line. **It is decided that PP should ensure:-**


(a) **Regular quarterly monitoring of treated effluent should be carried out by PP through MPPCB and if any of the parameter is found to be above the prescribed standard limits. PP should**



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- ensure the redressal measures immediately so that the water quality of treated effluent confirms the prescribed norms.
- (b) The entire treated waste water should be recycled as proposed by PP and there should be no discharge of treated waste water outside the premises.
- (c) The discharge of extra treated waste water (if any) should be linked with municipal sewer line.
- (d) MPPCB should ensure the quality of treated effluent.
- (iv). Approximately 1546.30 kg / day of Municipal Solid waste shall be generated and is proposed to be segregated separately at source. PP has submitted letter from Jabalpur Municipal Corporation dtd 12.12.14 regarding disposal of solid waste. **It is decided that PP should ensure linkage with Municipal Corporation Jabalpur for final disposal of MSW.**
- (v). Bio Medical waste approximately 284 kg/day will be generated and collected as per the Bio Medical waste handling and management rules and shall be treated in common disposal facility at Elite Engineers, Jabalpur (MP) for which PP has submitted agreement letter (dtd 03.12.2014). **It is decided that, Bio Medical Waste (Handling and management) rules should be followed strictly for the disposal of bio medical waste.**
- (vi). The maximum height of the building is 12.5 m (T & CP approved map dtd. 22.10.14). PP has provided road width 18 m; Front MOS 15 m and side/rear MOS 7.5 m. **It is decided that PP should ensure road width and open spaces as per MPBhumi Vikas Niyam 2012.**
- (vii). PP has proposed to provide Fire Hydrant System, Wet Riser, Yard Hydrants, Automatic Sprinkler System, Fire detection and alarm system, Public address system, Hand Appliances/Fire Extinguishers etc. as per NBC 2005. **It is decided that as per MPBVR, 2012 rule 42 (3) PP should submit necessary drawings and details to the Authority (Nagar Nigam, Jabalpur) incorporating all the fire fighting measures recommended in National Building Code part – IV point no. 3.4.6.1. The occupancy permit shall be issued by Nagar Nigam only after ensuring that all fire fighting measures are physically in place.**
- (viii). PP has proposed rain water harvesting through rooftop areas and recharging pits for artificial recharge of ground water.
- (ix). The total power requirement is 2267 KW. PP has also proposed power back up 2 D.G. sets of capacity 1500 and 1250 KVA. The source of power supply is MP Electricity Board. **It is decided that PP should ensure installation of photovoltaic cells (solar panels) for lighting in common areas, LED light fixtures and energy efficient equipments.**
- (x). As per MPBVR 2012 (rule no. 84) the requirement of car parking is **787 ECS** (630 for institute+157 residential) PP has proposed to provide total car parking of **847 ECS** (Stillt 5811.69/30=194ECS; open


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16334.69/25=653 ECS). It is decided that PP should ensure car parking as per Rule no.84(1)Table Clause1(3) of MPBVR 2012.

- (xi). Out of the total land (8.54 ha.) an area of 9072.68 sq.m (10.6%) is proposed to be developed as green area. **The authority decided that PP should ensure that Plantation is done in two rows all along the periphery of the project area, parks and avenue plantation along the roads with one tree per 100 sq. m. of the plot area. PP should ensure plantation of the trees of indigenous local varieties like Neem, Peepal, Kadam, Kachnaar etc. Every effort should be made to protect the existing trees on the plot.**

- (5) The Authority decided to accept the recommendations of 172nd SEAC meeting dtd. 22.02.15 **with 05 special conditions and accord Environmental Clearance** to "Global Institute of Medical Science & Health Care" at Khasra No. 141, 142/9, 142/10, 147/1, 181, 182/1, 182/2, 183/1, 183/2, 183/3, 212 & 244; Village Raigwan, Tehsil & District Jabalpur (MP); Total Plot Area 8.54 ha; Total Built up Area 88362.74 sqm. by Global Institute of Medical Sciences and Health Care through Partner Shri Saurabh Baderia, Baderia Pharma, 440, Wright Town, Jabalpur - 482002 **subject to all specific conditions imposed by SEIAA in its meetings.**

(ii) The average depth of the pit shall not exceed 6.0m at the end of lease period.



Copy of the letter should be enclosed to PP also.**






