- (1) This is a project pertaining to mining of Iron Ore, Laterite, Clay & Ochre Mine in MLA of 4.54 ha. The activity is mentioned at S.No. 1 (a) of the Schedule of EIA Notification 2006 as amended from time to time. The project is reported to be at a distance of more than 10 km from National Park /Sanctuary etc. thus it is not attracted by the general conditions and falls under category 'B-1" by virtue of its location and mining lease area. The case was forwarded by SEIAA to SEAC for appraisal of EIA for environment clearance for the project. It was submitted that this is a proposed mine having valid lease period upto 12.12.2043 with enhancement in production capacity from 16121 TPA of Iron ore & Laterite to 171689 TPA of Iron Ore and 71270 TPA of Laterite.
- (2) It was reported by the PP that the lease area was granted to M/s RMG Super Mines Pvt. Ltd, 33, Jagaran Bhawan, Press Complex, M.P.Nagar, Bhopal for 30 years period w.e.f. 13.12.2013 to 12.12.2043. The Mining Plan has been approved by IBM, Vide no. MP/Jabalpur/Iron Ore/ MPLN/ MOD 31/ 2016-17 dtd 09.02.2017.
- (3) SEAC in its 356<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting dtd 30.03.2019 has recommended the case with 30 special conditions for issuance of EC.
