In context of above it has been decided to delist the case from MPSEIAA on the basis of the tenure of SEIAA will be over on 09 th April, 2021 as per EIA Notification 2006 & its amendment " In the absence of a duly constituted SEIAA or SEAC, a Category 'B' project shall be treated as a Category 'A' project; Copy to PP and all concerned.

PP vide letter dtd. 02.07.2021 received in SEIAA office on 05.07.2021 requested to relist the case by showing his interest to present the case. Therefore, it has been decided to relist the case and send the technical file to SEAC for appraisal. Copy to PP and all concerned."


In view of above decision, the case is hereby relisted. The technical file is being sent for appraisal and you are requested to take the considered view on it.
