The case was scheduled for presentation and discussion wherein it was observed per the Google image based on coordinates provided by PP, that there is a bridge exists towards southern side and the most part of lease is submerged in the water so mining in this condition is not possible. It was further observed by committee that the submergence is due to back water of Samoha Reservoir. PP submitted that the mining is possible after January of every year when water recedes down. Committee also referred the past images available on the Google wherein in most of the pictures the lease is submerged in back water of reservoir. Thus committee after deliberation recommends that PP in this situation this case cannot be considered for grant of EC and case file may be sent to SEIAA for onward necessary action.

As per above recommendation of SEAC, it is decided to reject the case as case can not be considered for grant of EC considering environmental sensitivity. Copy to PP and all concerned.
