- (a) **Regarding Powder/dust factor related to manual mining must be worked out and displayed in the documents. This will ensure the estimation of suspended particulate matter (SPM) generated and will help in understanding the hazardous effect on mine workers, to evaluate the potential of occupational diseases.**

Reply-

Very humbly, the subject lease is proposed for mining of major mineral with fully mechanised method which has been detailed out in various section for chapter -2 and in mining plan which is approved by IBM Govt of India. The subject ToR condition is not applicable for such kind of mining project.

Further in the subject mine there is no point source of emission, fugitive dust emission in terms of SPM (now it called as PM-10 and PM 2.5) will be

generated which is properly estimated and predicted also in section 4.3.2.2 of Chapter-4 of EIA study report . Relevant pages are being enclosed as **Annexure-5** to the Letter for your kind consideration

- **Global warming potential and carbon foot print of the industrial activities should be studied and discussed in details during EIA study.**

Reply: Very humbly the subject proposal is comes under mining category whereas in ToR condition, carbon sequestration has been asked for industrial activity. In aforesaid proposal no industrial activity is proposed. However in the subject proposal, following will be aspect of carbon sequestration.

About 18 dumpers required per day basis. It is estimated that 2.62 kg of CO₂ is emitted from burning of 1 lit of HSD. It is estimated that one dumper required 1liter HSD required for running of 3km and transport route is 0.688km hence 0.23liter HSD required for one dumper hence 0.46 liter required for to and fro basis. For 18 dumpers required 8.28liter HSD per day basis. About 21.69kg CO₂ will be generated per day basis and 6508kg CO₂ will be generated yearly basis (300 working days). On an average one trees consumes 21 kg of CO₂ per year, hence to meet out the control of CO₂, total 310numbers of trees are required, where as we have planted more than 15600 Trees will be planted within lease area.

Sand and gravel shall not be extracted up to a distance of 1 kilometer (1Km) from major bridges and highways on both sides, or five times (5x) of the span (x) of a bridge/public civil structure (including water intake points) on up-stream side and ten times (10x) the span of such bridge on down-stream side, subjected to a minimum of 250 meters on the upstream side and 500 meters on the downstream side.

No in-stream mining is allowed. Established water conveyance channels should not be relocated, straightened, or modified.
